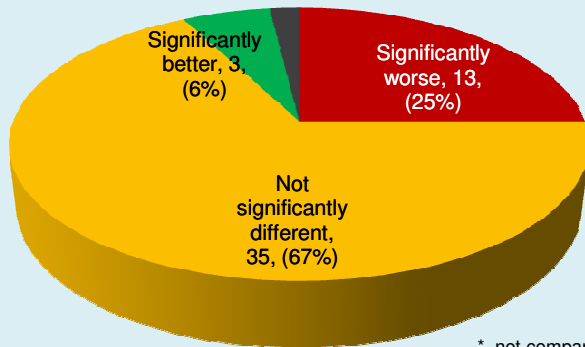


Ward Health Profile 2014: Brookside

Overview

• The health of people who live in Brookside Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Brookside compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.

• The proportion of people aged under 16 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.

• Life expectancy for men and women is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.

• Brookside is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in the borough for deprivation. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England with more than one quarter of people living in income deprived households. More than two fifths of children under 16 live in poverty (the fourth highest proportion in the borough) and more than one fifth of older people are in deprivation.

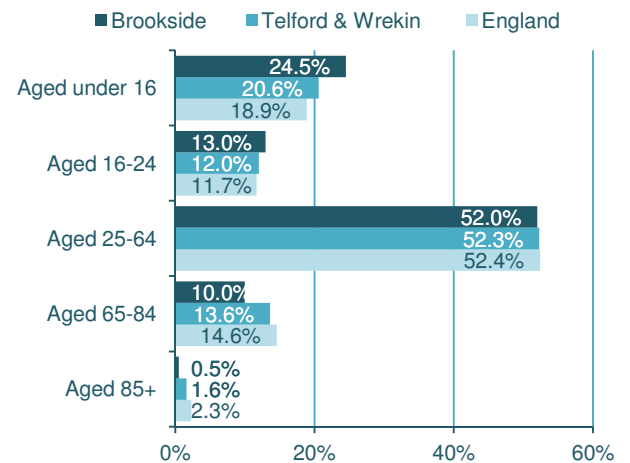
• The rate of emergency hospital admissions for all causes, coronary heart disease and heart attack is significantly worse than the England average.

• The rate of hospital stays for self harm is significantly worse than the England average and is the fourth worst in the borough.

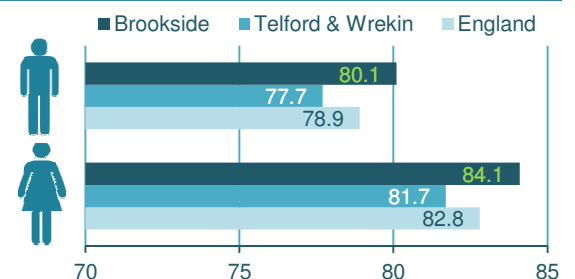


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Population age profile



Life expectancy



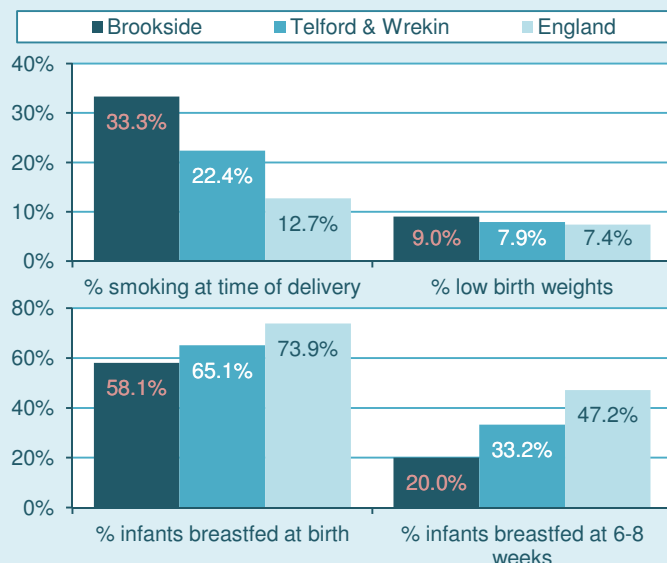
Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

● The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (33.3%) is more than two and a half times the England average and is the second worst rate in the borough.

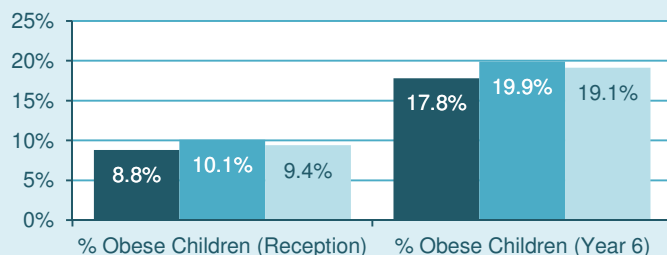
Breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (20.0%) is worse than the England average and is the second worst rate in the borough.

Low birth weights in babies (9.0%) and the proportion of infants breastfed at birth (58.1%) are worse than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity

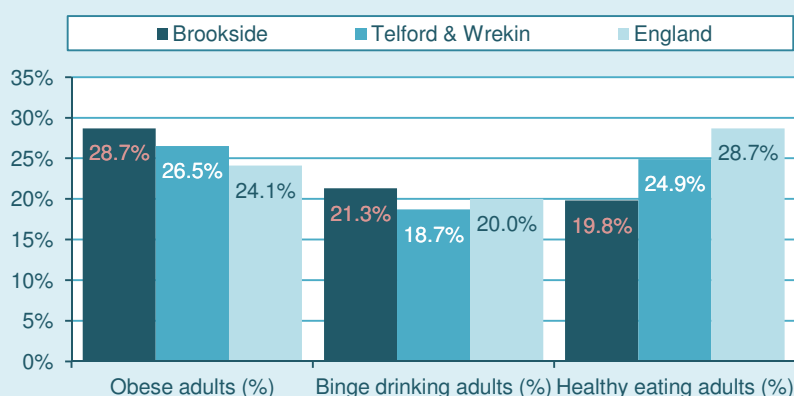
● The level of reception year (8.8%) and year 6 obesity (17.8%) is better than borough and statistically similar to the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

● The level of adult binge drinking (21.3%), obesity (28.7%) and healthy eating (19.8%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



Smoking cessation

● The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months from September 2013 (55%) is similar to the borough average (56%).

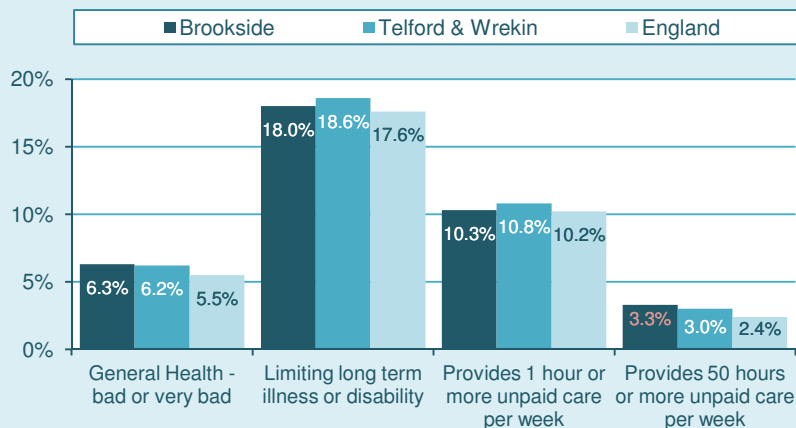

Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (6.3%), long term illnesses or disability (18.0%) and providing one hour or more unpaid care per week (10.3%) is similar to the borough and England average.

The proportion of people who provide 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (3.3%) is statistically worse than the England average.



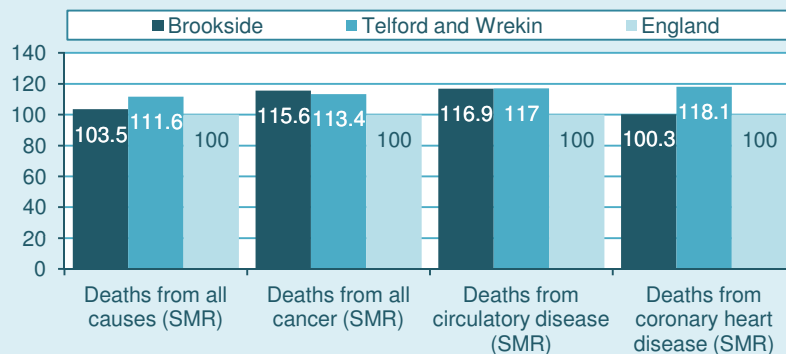
Early deaths

The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Brookside is statistically similar to the England average for:

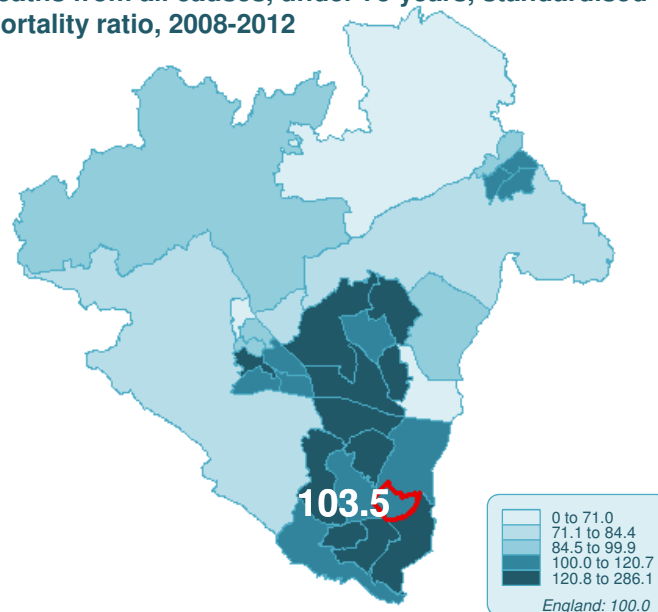
- deaths from all causes
- deaths from all cancers
- deaths from circulatory disease
- deaths from heart disease

Brookside is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Brookside (103.5) is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin (111.6) and the ward is ranked 12 out of 33 in the borough. This compares with the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.



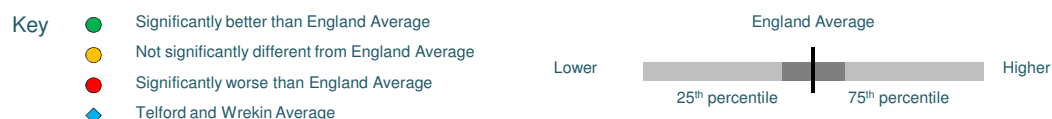
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
