
# Ward Health Profile 2014: Church Aston & Lilleshall

#### Overview

• The health of people who live in Church Aston & Lilleshall Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Church Aston & Lilleshall compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.





- The proportion of people aged between 65 and 84, and 85+ in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men and women is not significantly different from the average for England.
- Church Aston & Lilleshall is one of the least deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are better than the borough average and are significantly better than the average for England.
- The ratio of emergency hospital admissions for people living in the ward is significantly better than the England average and is the second best in the borough. The emergency admission ratio for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is also significantly better than the England average and is the third best ratio in Telford & Wrekin.
- The ratio of hospital stays for self harm is better than the England average and is the second best ratio in the borough.




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#### Population age profile






#### Starting Well


#### Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies (3.6%), and mothers breastfeeding at birth (85.0%) and at 6-8 weeks (52.2%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (20.0%) is better than the borough average but worse than the average for England.



### Childhood obesity


The level of obesity in reception year children (8.2%) and year 6 (15.8%) is better than the borough and England average.

### Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult obesity (22.7%) and healthy eating (31.6%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The level of binge drinking amongst adults 18.8%) in Church Aston & Lilleshall is estimated to be similar to the borough and England average.



### **Smoking cessation**

The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (53%) is worse in Church Aston & Lilleshall than the borough average (56%).

#### Health and Care

- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (5.0%) and long term illness or disability (17.5%) is better than the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people who provide 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.7%) is similar to the borough and England average.

The proportion providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (12.3%) is worse than the borough and England average.




#### Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in Church Aston & Lilleshall is better than the borough average and statistically similar to the England average for:
  - · deaths from all causes
  - · deaths from all cancers
  - · deaths from circulatory disease
  - · deaths from heart disease

Church Aston & Lilleshall is ranked in the second best fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Church Aston & Lilleshall (83.1) is the sixth best in the borough. This compares with the average ratio for Telford & Wrekin of 111.6, the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.
