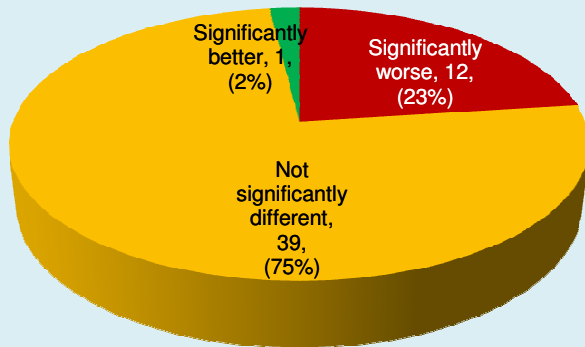


Ward Health Profile 2014: College

Overview

• The health of people who live in College Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how College compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



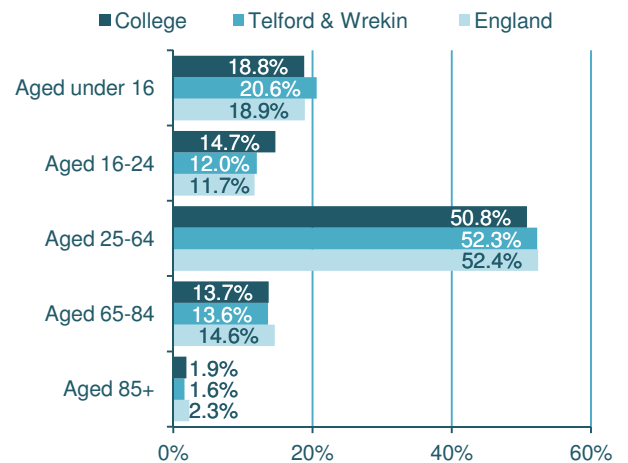

- The proportion of people aged 16-24 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women, life expectancy is better than the average for the borough and for England.
- College is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in the borough for deprivation. Levels of income deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England and nearly one third of children under 16 years live in poverty.
- Emergency hospital admission rates in the ward for all causes and for coronary heart disease are significantly worse than the England average. Admission rates for coronary heart disease are the fourth worst in the borough and the fifth worst for all causes.

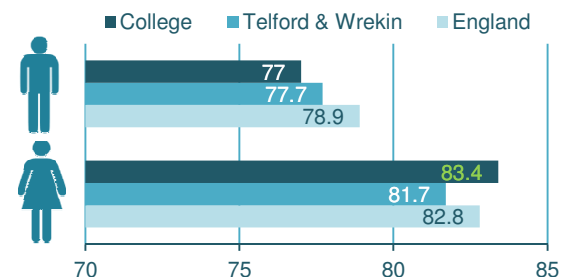

Population age profile



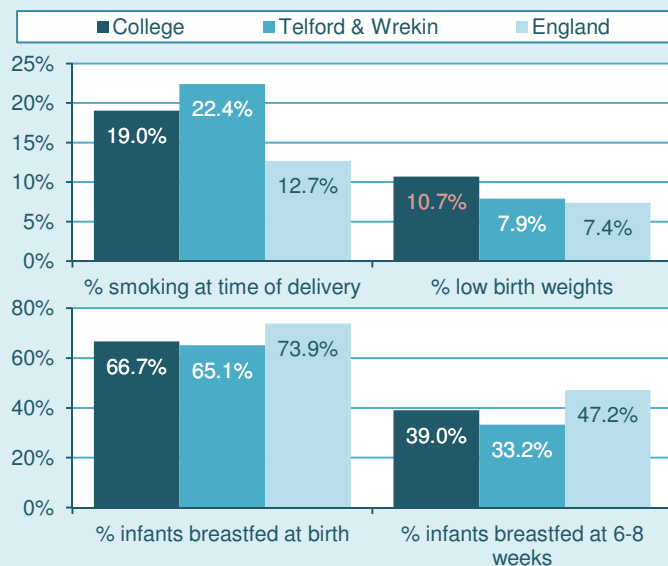

Starting Well

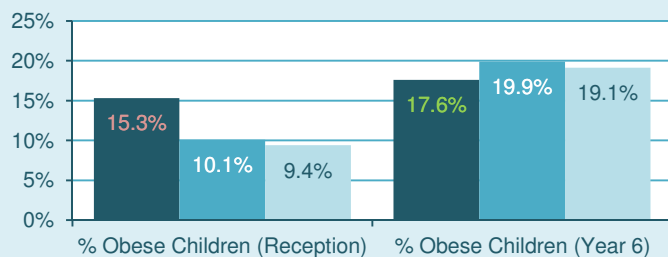
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of mothers in College ward smoking at the time of delivery (19.0%), breastfeeding at birth (66.7%) and at 6-8 weeks (39.0%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average
- The proportion of low birth weight babies (10.7%) is worse than the borough and England average



Childhood obesity

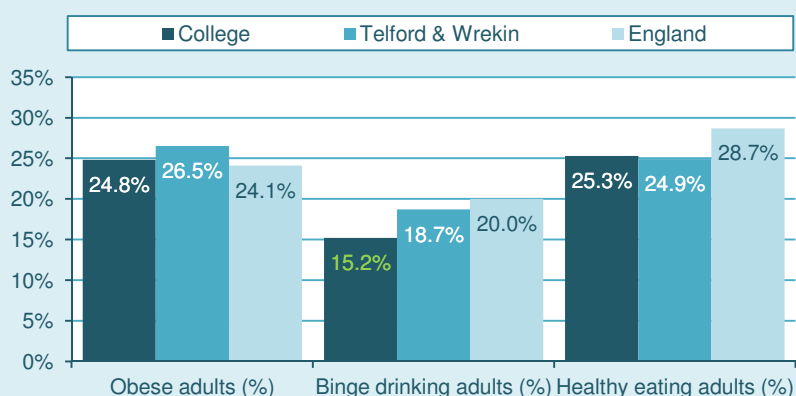
- The level of obesity in year 6 children (17.6%) is better than the borough and England average.
- Obesity in reception year children (15.3%) in the ward is worse than the borough and England average



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of binge drinking in adults (15.2%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The level of adult obesity (24.8%) and healthy eating (25.3%) is estimated to be better than or similar to the borough average and worse than the England average.



Smoking cessation

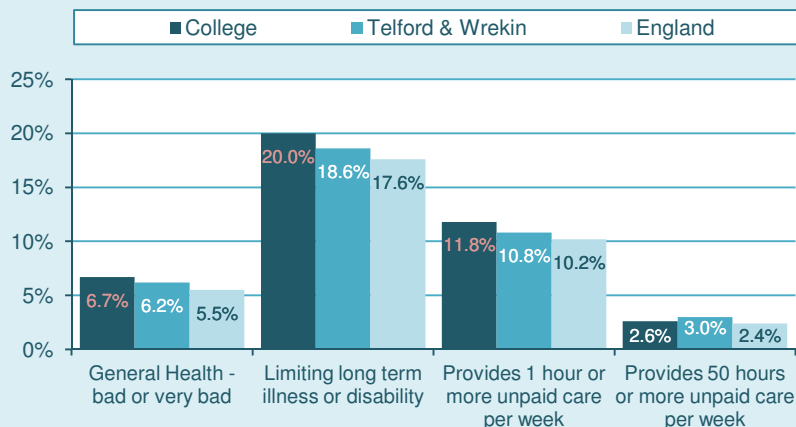
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (55%) is similar to the borough average (56%).

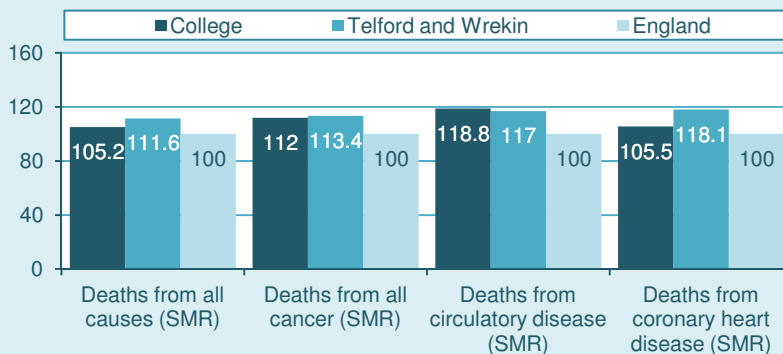
Health and Care

- The proportion of people in the ward providing 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.6%) is better than the borough and similar to the England average.
- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (6.7%), long term illnesses or disability (20.0%) and providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (11.8%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Early deaths

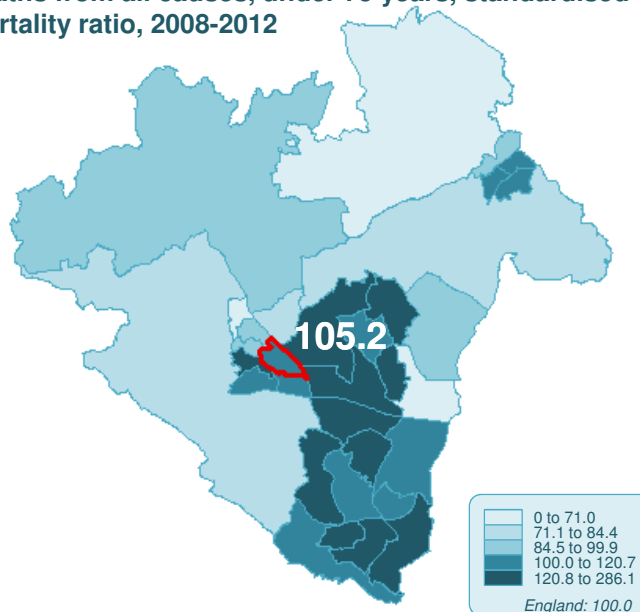
- The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in College is similar to the borough average and statistically similar to the England average for:
 - deaths from all causes
 - deaths from all cancers
 - deaths from circulatory disease
 - deaths from heart disease



College is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths in the ward (105.2) compares to the Telford & Wrekin average (111.6). The ward is ranked 13 out of 33 in the borough for early deaths from all causes, the best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin is 60.9.

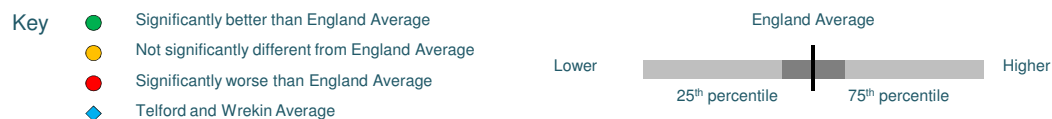
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
