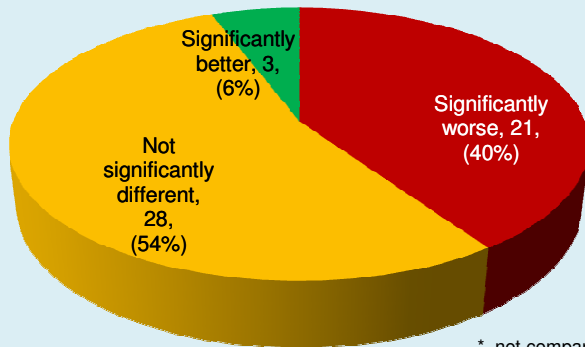


# Ward Health Profile 2014: Cuckoo Oak

## Overview

• The health of people who live in Cuckoo Oak Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Cuckoo Oak compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



\* not compared = 1 (2%)

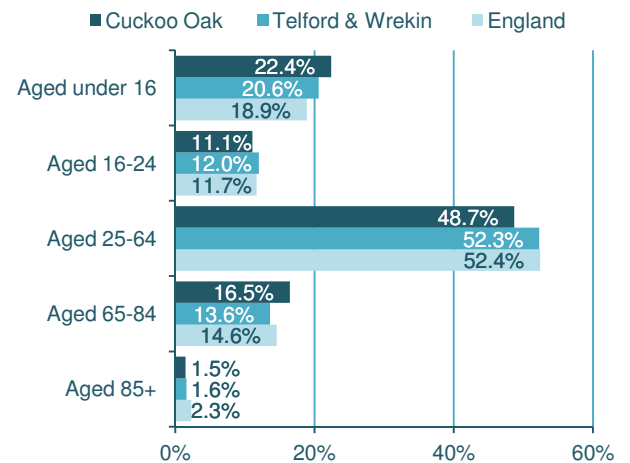

- The proportion of people aged under 16 and 65 to 84 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men and women is lower than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Cuckoo Oak is one of the most deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England. Three in ten people in the ward live in income deprived households, whilst half of the children aged under 16 years live in poverty.
- The emergency hospital admission rate for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and from all causes is significantly worse than England.
- The admission rate for elective hip replacement in Cuckoo Oak is the worst in the borough.
- The hospital admission rate for self harm is also worse than the England average and is the fifth worst rate in Telford & Wrekin.

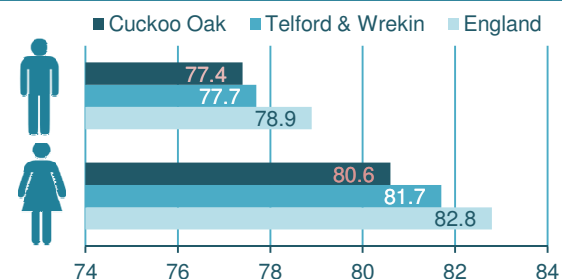


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## Population age profile

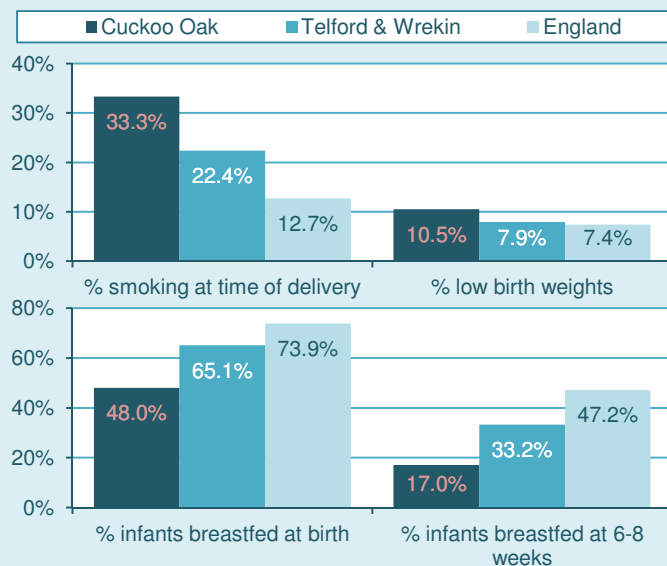


## Starting Well

### Pregnancy and Maternity

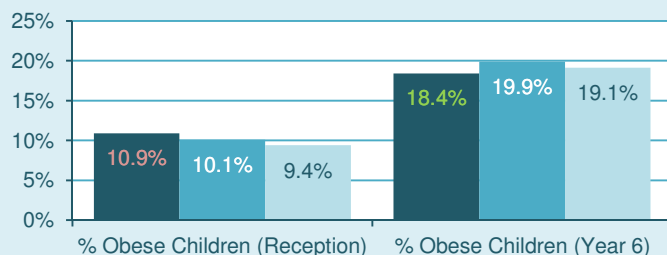
- The proportion of low birth weight babies (10.5%) in Cuckoo Oak, breastfeeding at birth (48.0%) and at 6-8 weeks (17.0%) is worse than the borough and England average.

The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (33.3%) is more than two and a half times the England average and is the joint second worst rate in the borough.



### Childhood obesity

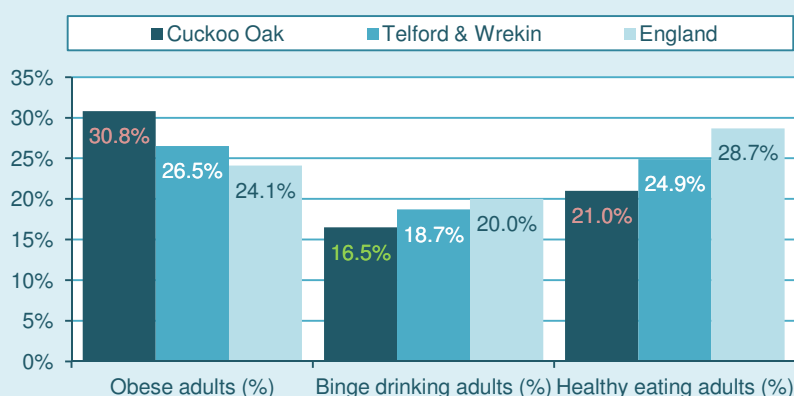
- The level of obesity in year 6 children (18.4%) is better than the borough and England average.
- Obesity in reception year children (10.9%) is worse than the borough and England average.



## Living Well

### Adult lifestyle

- The proportion of adults who binge drink in Cuckoo Oak (16.5%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The level of adult obesity (30.8%) and healthy eating (21.0%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



### Smoking cessation

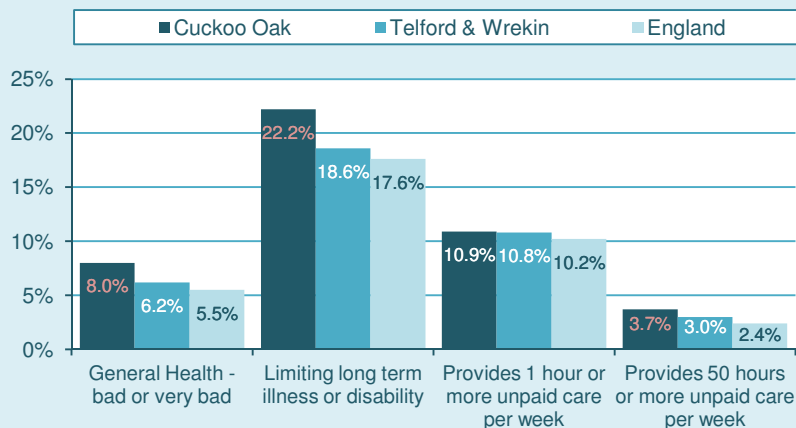
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (49%) is worse than the borough average (56%).

### Health and Care

- The proportion of people who provide 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (10.9%) in Cuckoo Oak is similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (8.0%), long term illnesses or disability (22.2%), and who provide 50 hours or more (3.7%) unpaid care per week is worse than the borough and England average.



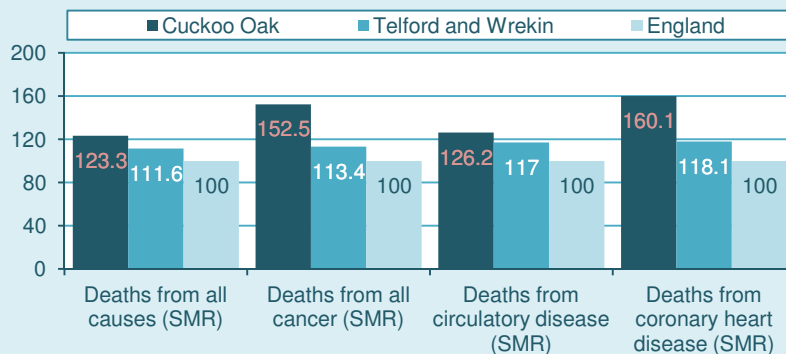
### Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in Cuckoo Oak is worse than the borough average and the England average for:
  - deaths from all causes
  - deaths from all cancers
  - deaths from circulatory disease
  - deaths from heart disease

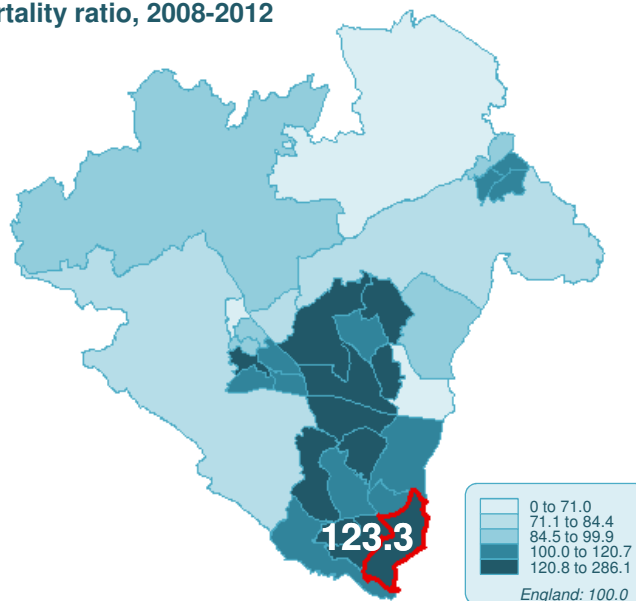
Cuckoo Oak is ranked in the fifth of all wards in England that have the worst ratio of deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths in Cuckoo Oak (123.3) is the tenth worst in the borough and compares to the best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin of 60.9.

The ratio of early deaths from all cancer (152.5) is the worst in the borough.



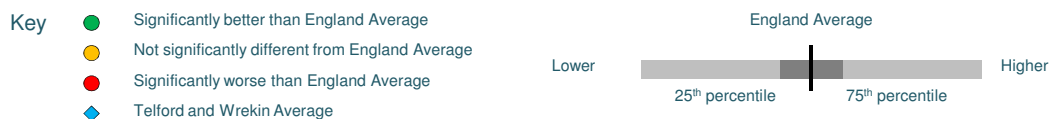
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
