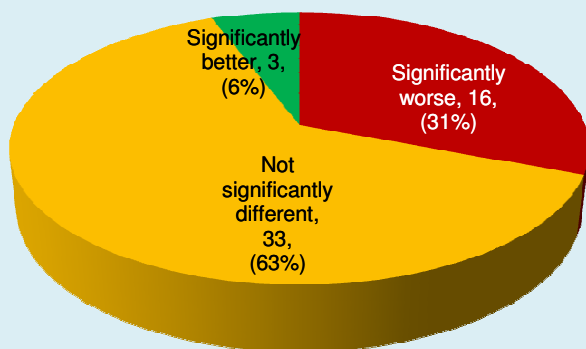


Ward Health Profile 2014: Dawley Magna

Overview

• The health of people who live in Dawley Magna Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Dawley Magna compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



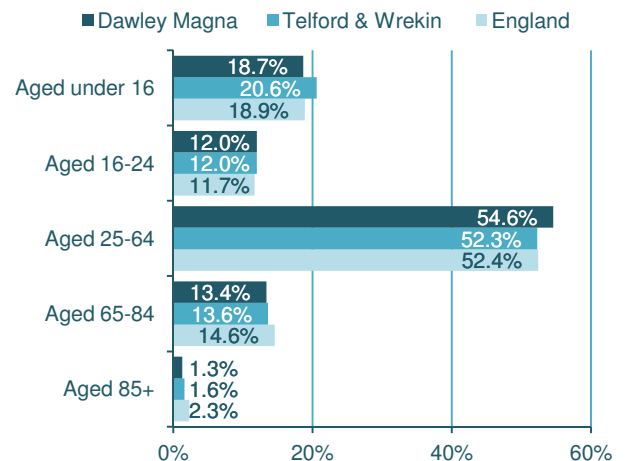

- The proportion of people aged between 25 and 64 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin. For women, it is similar to the average for England.
- Dawley Magna is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in the borough for deprivation. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England. One in five people in the ward live in income deprived households, and three in ten children under 16 years of age live in poverty.
- Emergency hospital admission rates for stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease are significantly worse than the England average.
- The rate of hospital stays for self harm is significantly worse than England and is the eighth worst in the borough.
- Hospital stays for alcohol related harm are significantly better than the England average.

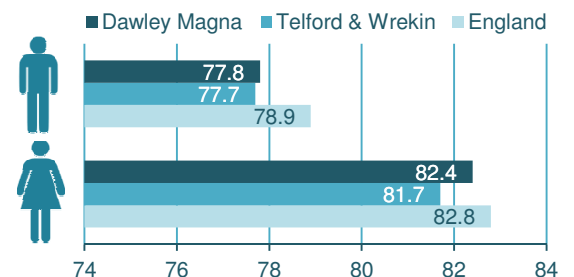


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Population age profile



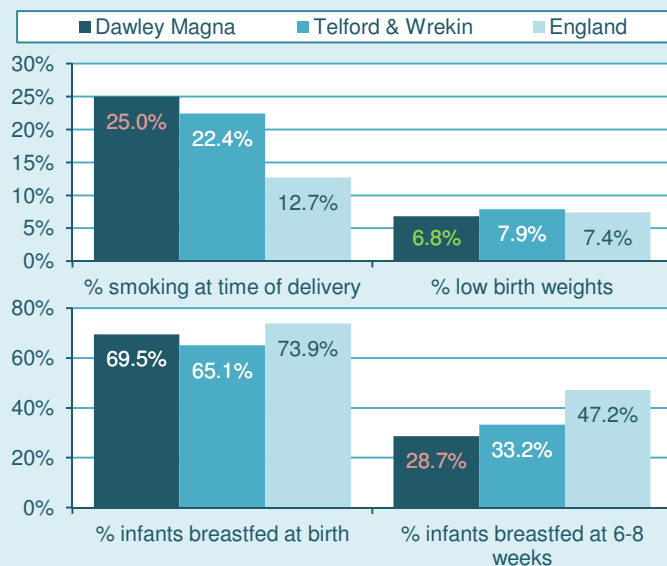

Starting Well

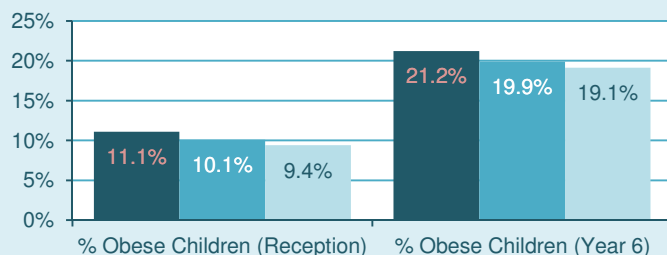
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies in Dawley Magna (6.8%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at birth (69.5%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average.
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (25.0%) and breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (28.7%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity

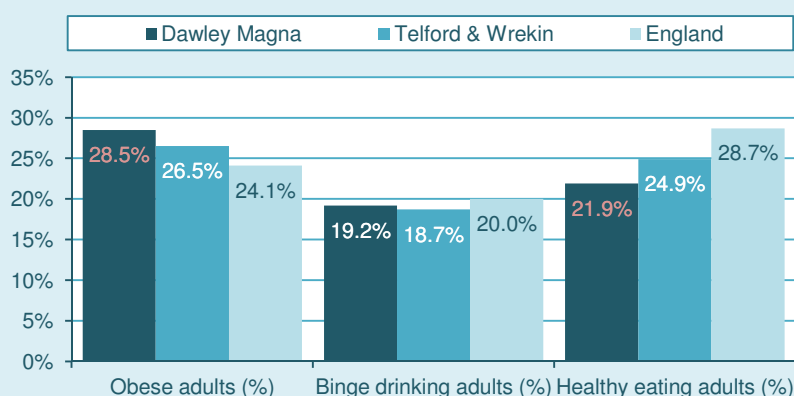
- The level of obesity in reception year (11.1%) and year 6 (21.2%) children is worse than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (19.2%) in Dawley Magna is estimated to be better than the borough but worse than the England average.
- The level of adult obesity (28.5%) and healthy eating (21.9%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



Smoking cessation

- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (54%) is similar to the borough average (56%).

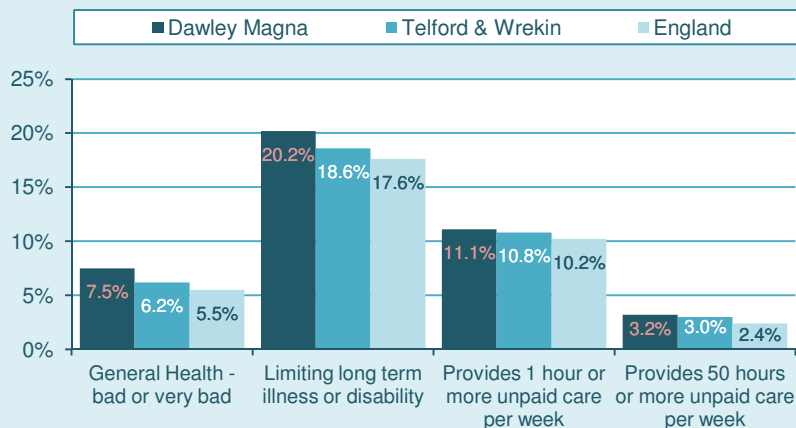

Health and Care

● The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (7.5%) and long term illnesses or disability (20.2%) is worse than the borough and England average.

The proportion of people providing 1 hour or more (11.1%) and 50 hours or more (3.2%) unpaid care per week, is worse in Dawley Magna than the borough and England average.



Early deaths

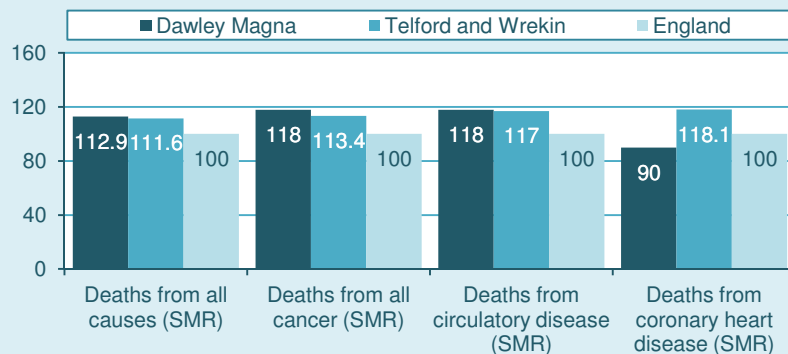
● The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in Dawley Magna is better than the borough average and statistically similar to the England average for deaths from heart disease.

● The ratio of early deaths is similar to the borough and England average for:

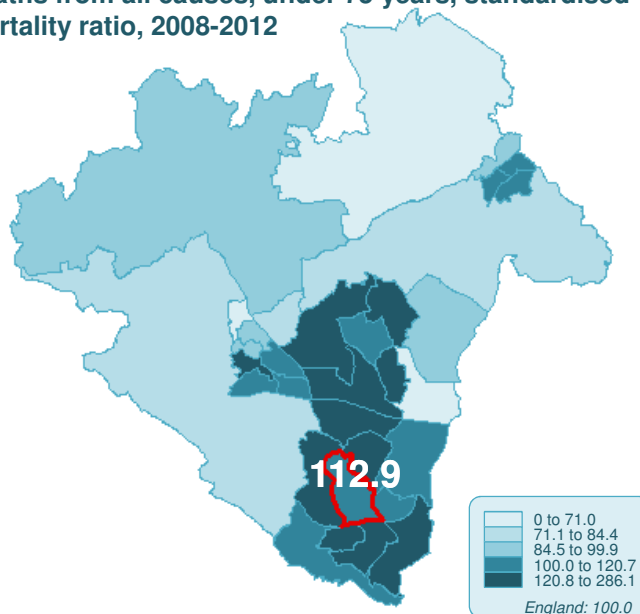
- deaths from all causes
- deaths from all cancer
- deaths from circulatory disease

Dawley Magna is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Dawley Magna (112.9) is the fifteenth worst in the borough and compares with the lowest ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the average for Telford & Wrekin of 111.6.



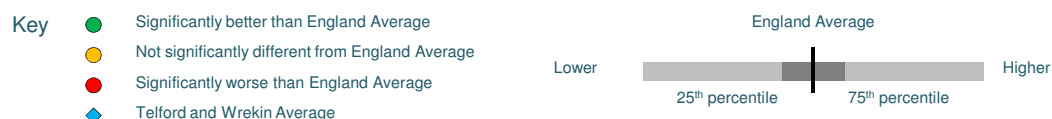
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
