
Ward Health Profile 2014: Donnington

Overview

• The health of people who live in Donnington Ward is generally significantly worse compared to the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Donnington compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.




- The proportion of people aged under 16 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men and women is worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin. For men, it is significantly worse than the average for England.
- Donnington is one of the most deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England, with part of the ward ranked in the 10% of most deprived areas in England. One quarter of people in the ward live in income deprived households, and more than one third of children under 16 years live in poverty.
- Emergency hospital admission rates for coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease are all significantly worse than the average for England. Emergency admission rates for all causes are the fourth worst in the borough.




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Population age profile


Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

The proportion of low birth weight babies in Donnington (7.2%) is better than the borough and similar to the England average.


Breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (34.3%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.

Smoking at time of delivery (23.6%) and breastfeeding at birth (57.5%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity


The level of obesity in reception year (16.3%) and year 6 (23.2%) children is worse than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (19.0%) is estimated to be similar to the borough and the England average.
- The level of adult obesity (29.9%) and healthy eating (18.3%) in Donnington is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



Smoking cessation

The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (61%) is better than the borough average (56%).



Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (9.1%) and long term illnesses or disability (23.6%) is worse than the borough and England average.

The proportion of people who provide 1 hour or more (11.3%) and 50 hours (4.3%) or more unpaid care per week is worse than the average for the borough and England





Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Donnington is worse than the borough average and significantly worse than the England average for:
 - · deaths from all causes
 - · deaths from all cancers
 - · deaths from circulatory disease
 - · deaths from heart disease

Donnington is ranked in the fifth of wards in England with the worst ratio of early deaths from all causes. The ratio of early mortality from all causes in the ward (155.6) is the worst in the borough. This compares with the average early mortality ratio for Telford & Wrekin of 111.6,the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.

The ward also has the worst ratio of early deaths from circulatory disease in the borough and the third worst ratio for early deaths from cancer and coronary heart disease.
