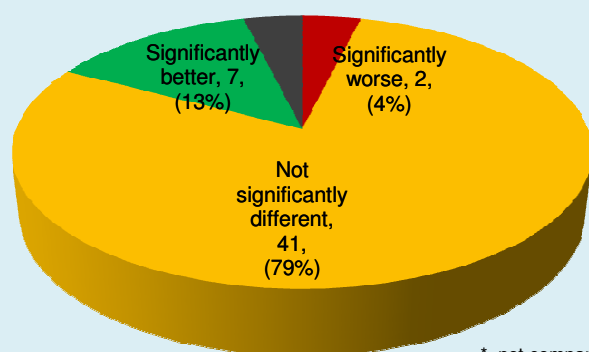


Ward Health Profile 2014: Dothill

Overview

- The health of people who live in Dothill Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Dothill compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



* not compared = 2 (4%)

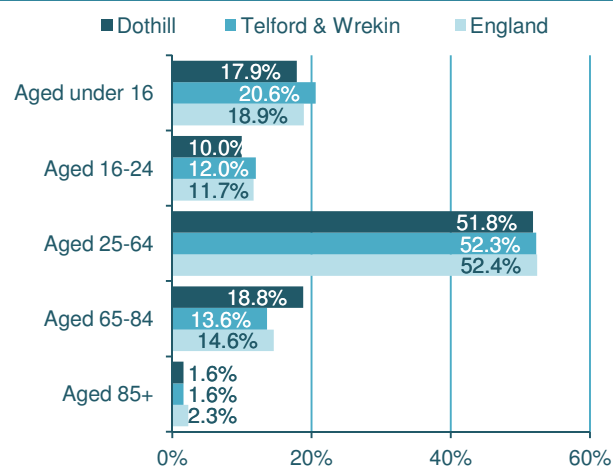

- The proportion of people aged between 65 and 84 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men and women is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Levels of deprivation in the ward are better than the borough average and are significantly better than the average for England.
- Emergency hospital admission rates in the ward are not significantly different from the average for England.
- The rate of hospital admissions for self-harm in Dothill is significantly better than the England average and is the third best rate in the borough.

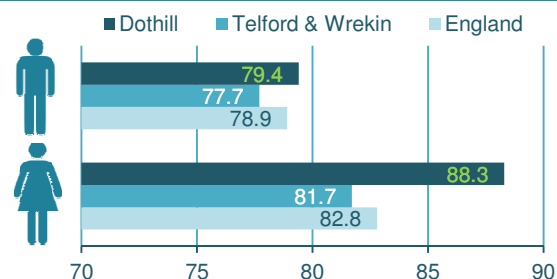


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Population age profile



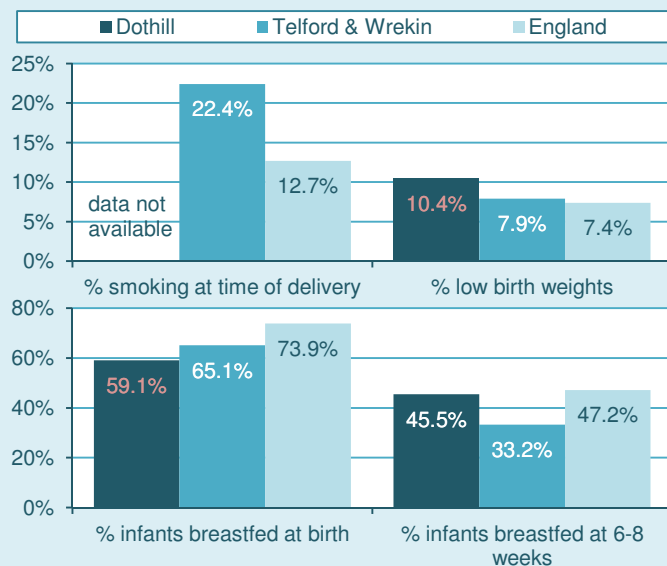

Starting Well

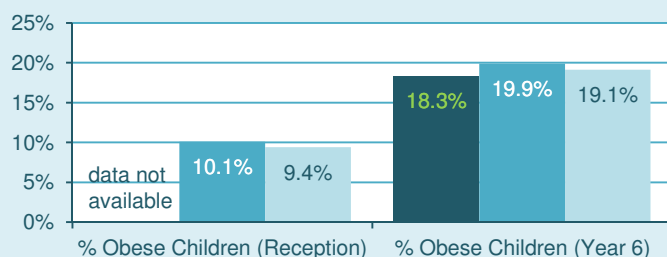
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of mothers in Dothill breastfeeding their babies at 6-8 weeks (45.5%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average.
- The proportion of low birth weight babies (10.4%) and level of breastfeeding at birth (59.1%) is worse than the borough and the England average.



Childhood obesity

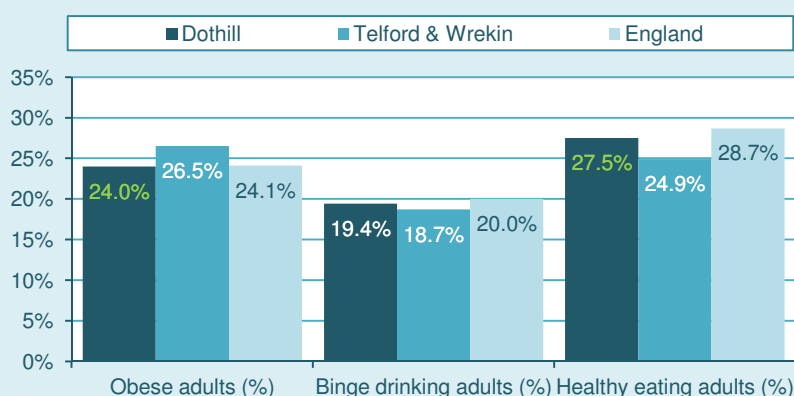
- The level of obesity in year 6 children (18.3%) is better than the borough and the England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The proportion of obese adults (24.0%) and healthy eating adults (27.5%) is estimated to be better than the borough and statistically similar to the England average.
- The level of adult binge drinking (19.4%) is estimated to be worse than the borough but statistically similar to the England average.



Smoking cessation

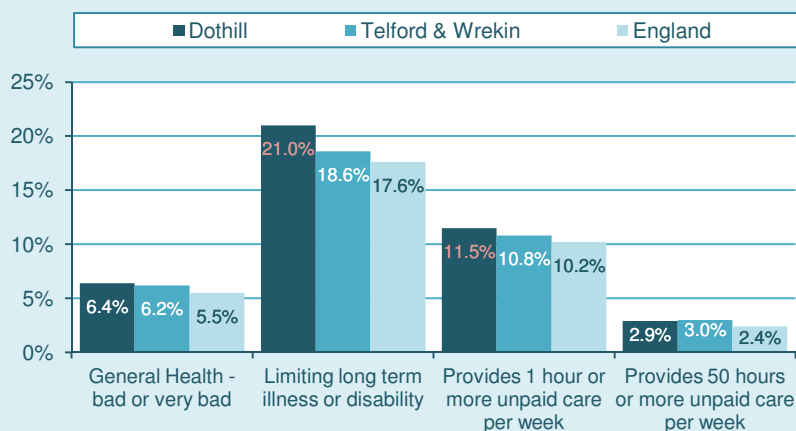
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (39%) is worse than the borough average (56%).

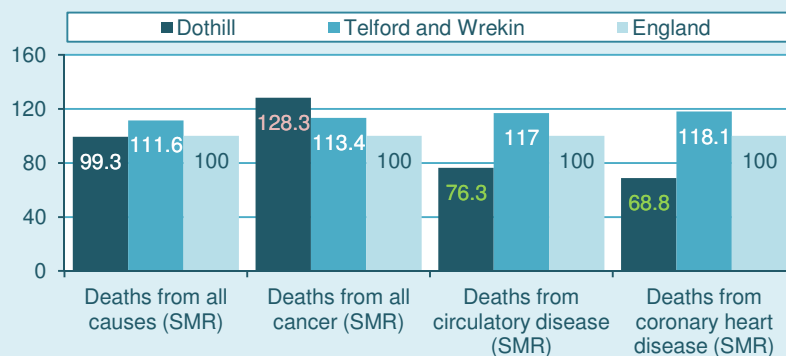
Health and Care

- The proportion of people providing 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.9%) and reporting bad or very bad health (6.4%) is similar to the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of people reporting long term illnesses or disability (21.0%) and providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (11.5%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Early deaths

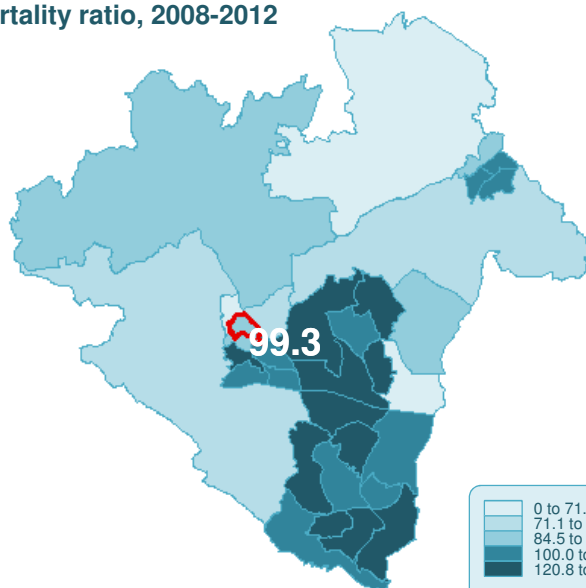
- The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in Dothill is better than the borough and England average for:
 - deaths from circulatory disease
 - deaths from heart disease
- The ratio of early deaths from all causes is similar to the England average.
- Early deaths from all cancers in Dothill is worse than the borough and England average.



Dothill is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes (99.3) is the eleventh best in the borough and compares with the borough average of 111.6 and the best ratio in the borough of 60.9.

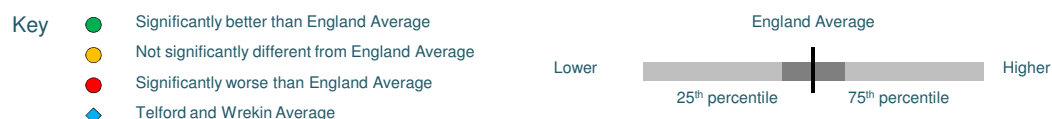
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
