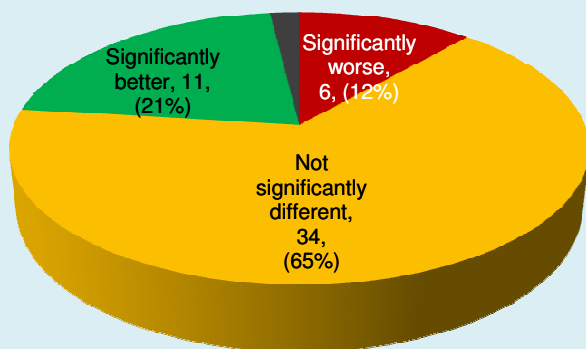


Ward Health Profile 2014: Ercall Magna

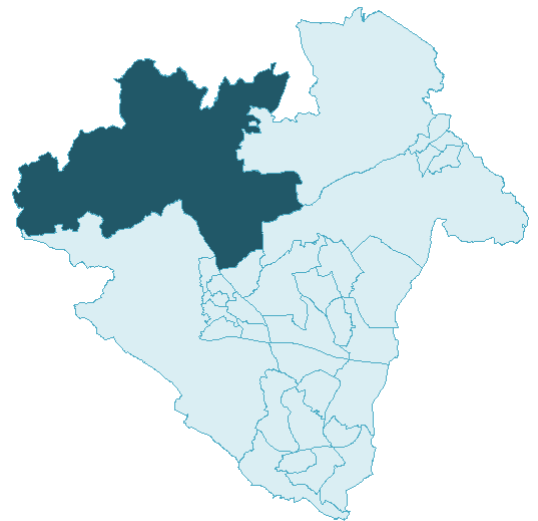
Overview

• The health of people who live in Ercall Magna Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and also England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Ercall Magna compares with England across 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



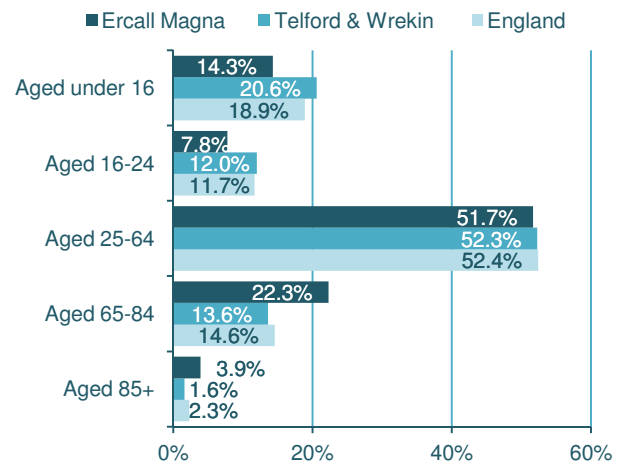

- The proportion of people aged 65 - 84 and 85 and above in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England.
- Life expectancy for men and women in Ercall Magna is better than the borough average.
- Ercall Magna is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in the borough for deprivation. Levels of income deprivation, child poverty and older people in deprivation are better than the borough average and significantly better than the average for England.
- Emergency hospital admission rates in Ercall Magna are significantly better than the England average for all causes, coronary heart disease and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.
- The hospital admission rate for elective hip replacement is worse than the England average and is the sixth worst rate in the borough.

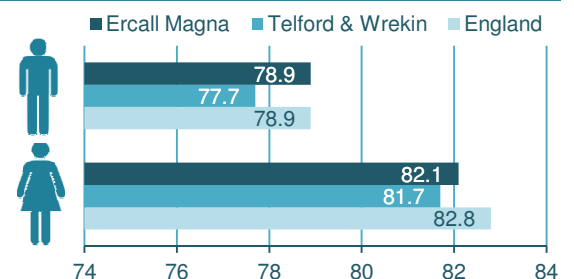


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Population age profile



Life expectancy



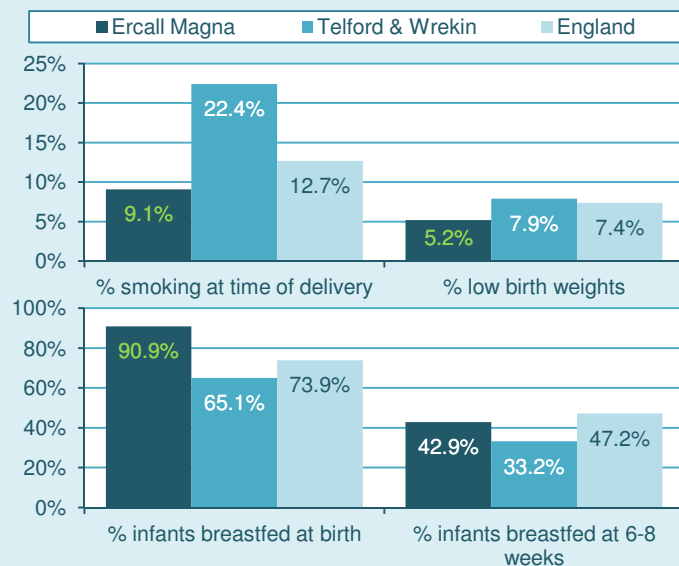
Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (9.1%) in Ercall Magna is better than the England average and is the fourth best rate in the borough.

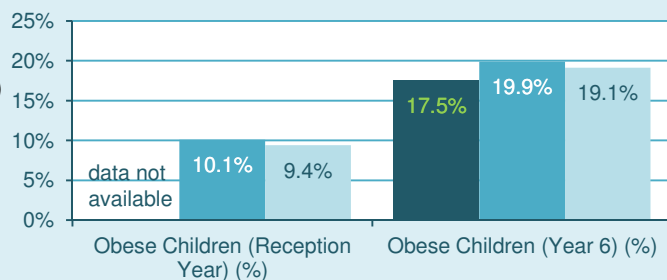
The proportion of babies with low birth weights (5.2%) and mothers breastfeeding at birth (90.9%) is better than the borough and England average.

- The proportion of mothers breastfeeding their babies at 6-8 weeks (42.9%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.



Childhood obesity

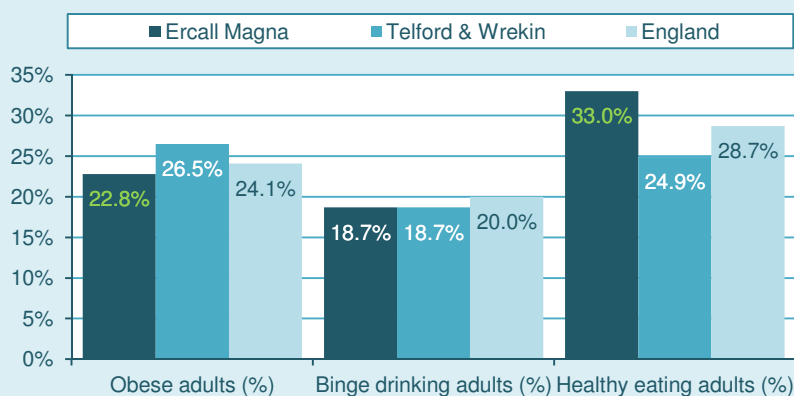
- The level of obesity in year 6 children (17.5%) is better than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult obesity (22.8%) and healthy eating (33.0%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The proportion of adults in Ercall Magna who binge drink (18.7%) is estimated to be similar to the borough average and statistically similar to the England average.



Smoking cessation

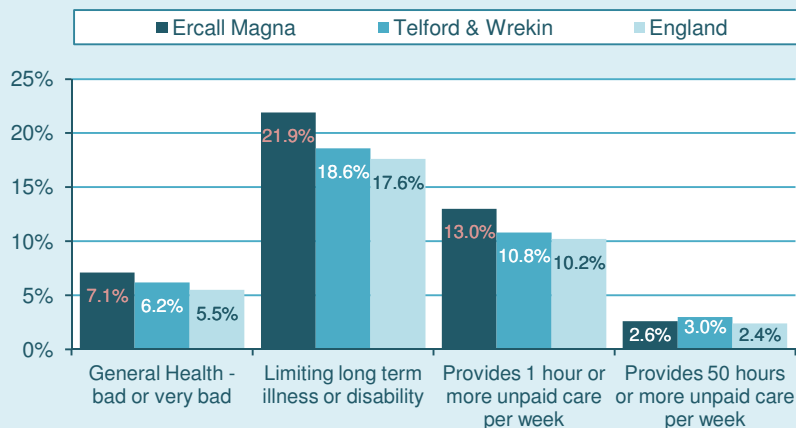
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months from September 2013 (56%), is similar to the borough average (56%).

Health and Care

- The proportion of people who provide 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.6%) is better than the borough average and similar to the England average.
- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (7.1%), long term illnesses or disability (21.9%) and providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (13.0%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Early deaths

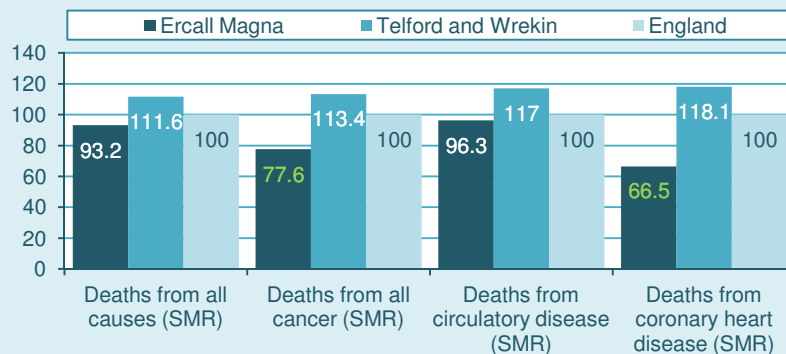
- The ratio of deaths among people under the age of 75 in Ercall Magna is better than the borough and England average for:
 - deaths from all cancer
 - deaths from heart disease

The ratio of early deaths is better than the borough average and similar to the England average for:

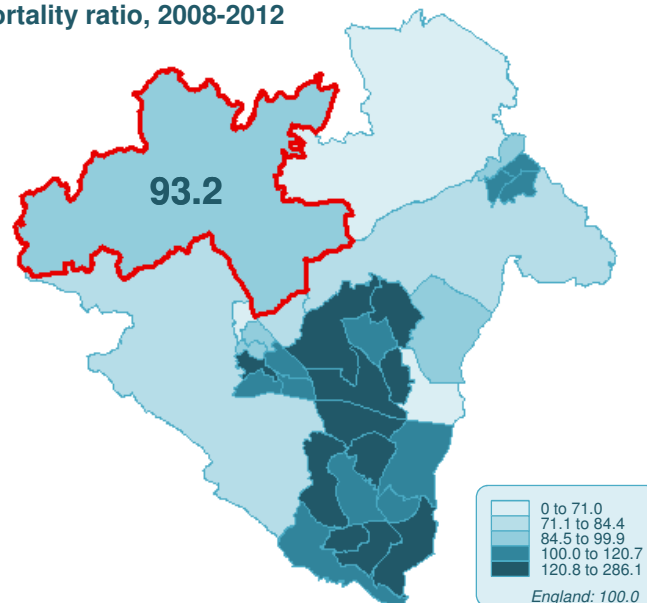
- deaths from all causes
- deaths from circulatory disease

Ercall Magna is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in England for the ratio of early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths in Ercall Magna (93.2) is the ninth best ratio in Telford & Wrekin and compares to the borough average (111.6) and the best ward ratio of 60.9.



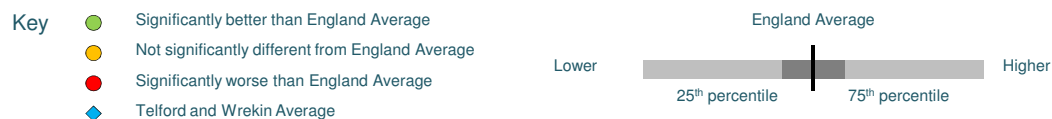
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
