
Ward Health Profile 2014: Ercall

Overview

• The health of people who live in Ercall Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Ercall compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.




- The proportion of people aged 65-84 and 85 plus in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England. For women, it is worse than the borough and England average.
- Levels of deprivation in the ward are similar to the average for the borough. Levels of income deprivation and child poverty in Ercall are significantly worse than the average for England, and more than one quarter of children under 16 in the ward are classed as living in poverty.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is similar to the borough and England average.
- The rate of hospital admissions for self harm in Ercall is the joint worst rate in the borough.




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Population age profile






Starting Well


Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies (7.0%) and infants breastfeeding at birth (78.9%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers in Ercall smoking at the time of delivery (21.1%) and breastfeeding their babies at 6-8 weeks (43.8%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average.



Childhood obesity


The level of obesity in year 6 children (16.7%) is better than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult obesity (23.1%) and binge drinking (17.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The proportion of healthy eating adults (26.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough but worse than the England average.



Smoking cessation


The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (68%) is better than the borough average (56%).



Ageing Well

Health and Care

- The proportion of people in Ercall reporting bad or very bad health (6.2%) and providing 50 hours or more care per week (2.9%) is similar to the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of people who provide 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (12.5%) and report a limiting long term illness or disability (21.1.%) is worse than the Telford & Wrekin and England average.




Early deaths


- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Ercall is better than the borough and England average for deaths from all cancers.
- It is similar to the borough and England average for deaths from all causes and from heart disease
- The ratio is worse than the borough and England average for deaths from circulatory disease

Ercall is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Ercall (114.1) is the thirteenth worst in the borough. The best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin is 60.9.

The ratio of early deaths from all cancer in Ercall (91.2) is the eighth best in the borough. The ratio of early deaths from circulatory disease (150.2) is the sixth worst.
