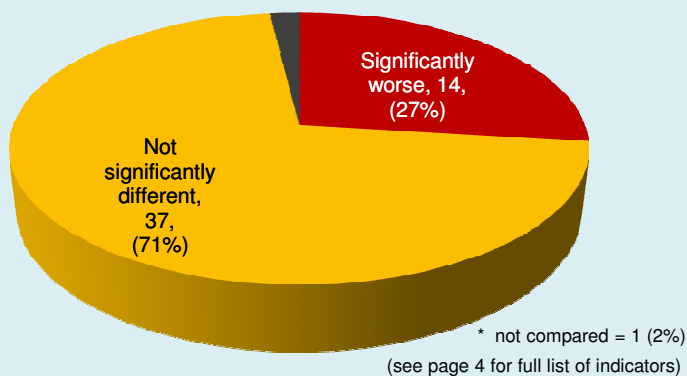


Ward Health Profile 2014: Haygate

Overview

• The health of people who live in Haygate Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Haygate compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.

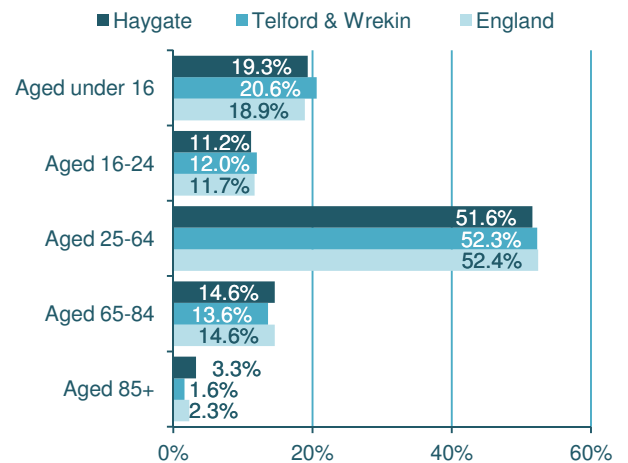


- The proportion of people aged 85 and over in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women, it is significantly worse than the average for England.
- Haygate is ranked among the more deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England for income deprivation and children under the age of 16 who are classed as living in poverty.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is similar to the borough and England average.
- The rate of hospital admissions for self harm in Haygate is the joint worst rate in Telford & Wrekin.

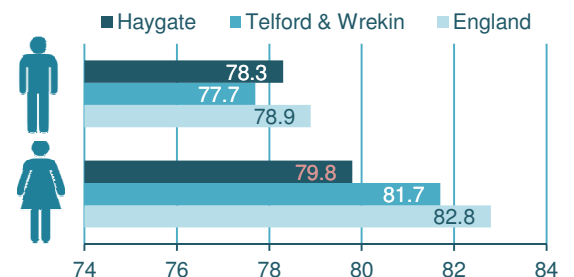


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Population age profile



Life expectancy



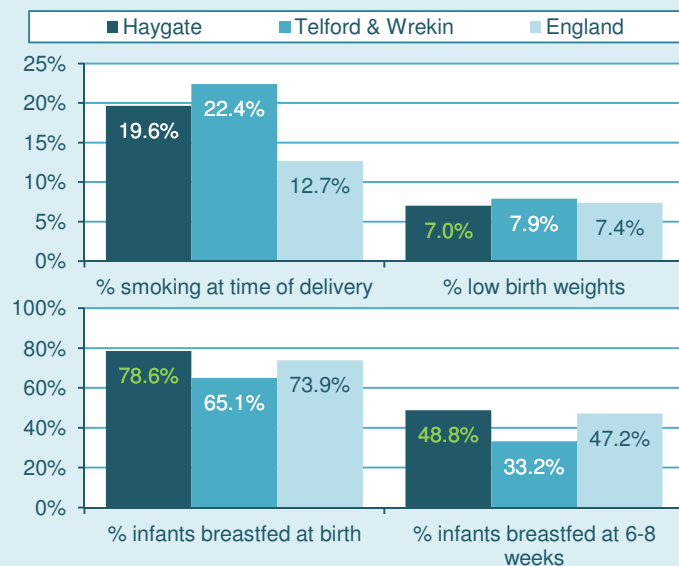
Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

● The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at birth (78.6%) and at 6-8 weeks (48.8%) is better in Haygate than the borough and the England average.

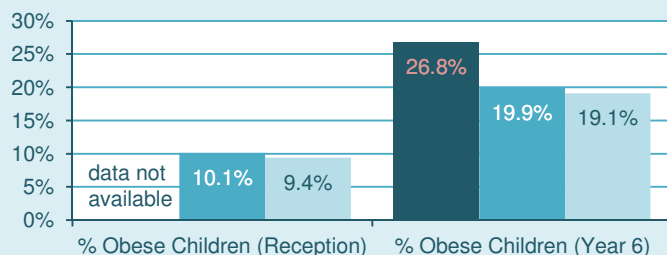
The proportion of babies with low birth weights (7.0%) is also better than the borough and England average.

● The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (19.6%) is better than the borough but worse than the England average.



Childhood obesity

● The level of obesity in year 6 children (26.8%) is worse than the borough and England average.

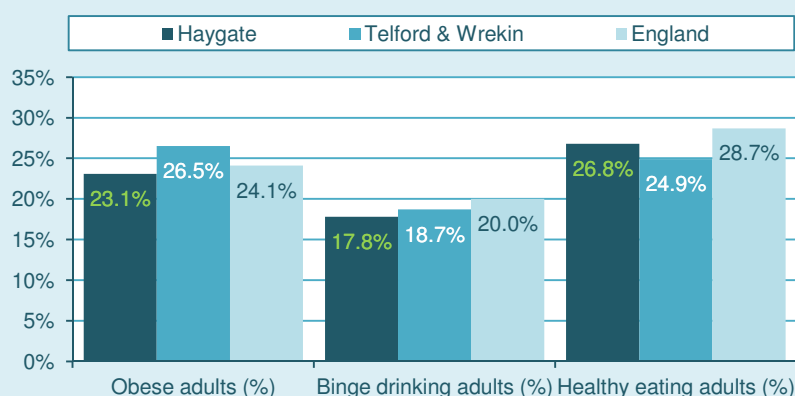


Living Well

Adult lifestyle

● The level of adult obesity (23.1%) and binge drinking (17.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.

The proportion of adults who eat healthily in Haygate (26.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough and statistically similar to the England average.



Smoking cessation

● The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (46%) is worse than the borough average (56%).

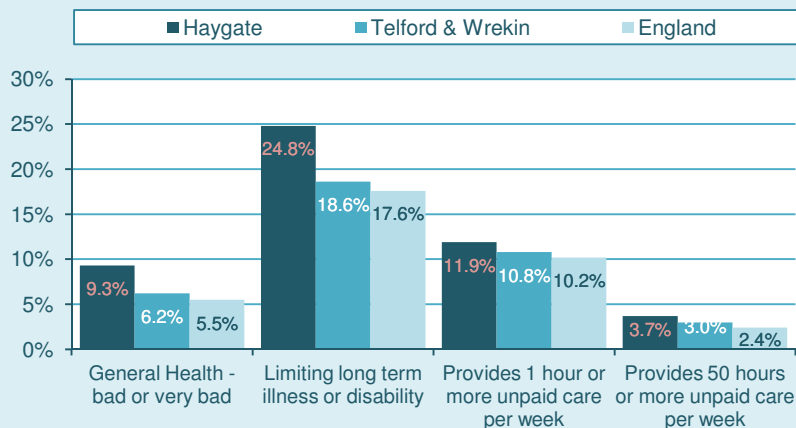

Health and Care

● The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (9.3%) and long term illnesses or disability (24.8%) is worse than the average for the borough and England

The proportion of people in Haygate who provide unpaid care for 1 hour or more (11.9%) and 50 hours or per week (3.7%) is worse than the average for the borough and England



Early deaths

● The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Haygate is similar to the borough and national average for deaths from all cancers

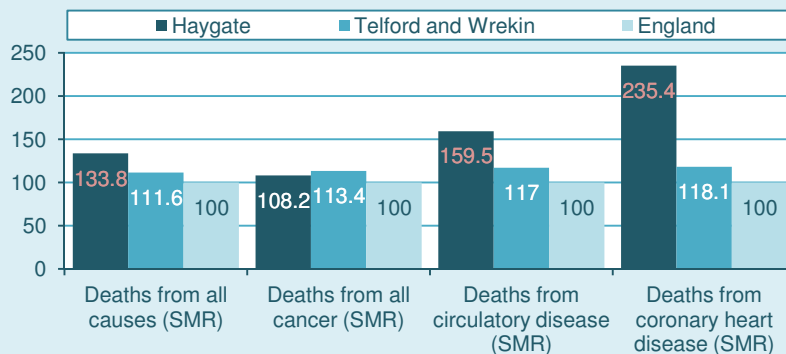
● The ratio is worse than the borough and the England average for:

- deaths from all causes
- deaths from circulatory disease
- deaths from heart disease

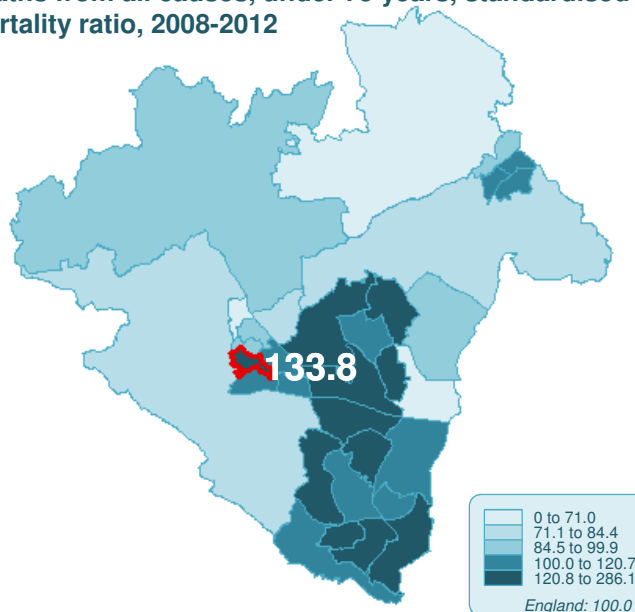
Haygate is ranked in the worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Haygate (133.8) is the fifth worst in the borough and compares with the Telford & Wrekin average of 111.6 and the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9.

The ratio of early deaths from coronary heart disease (235.4) is the worst in the borough.



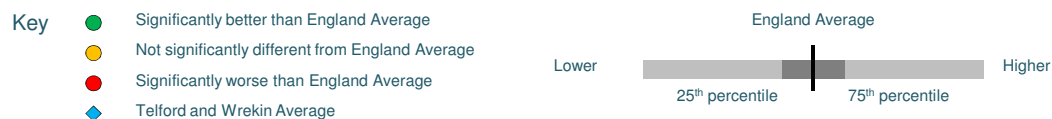
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
