
Ward Health Profile 2014: Ketley & Oakengates

Overview

• The health of people who live in Ketley & Oakengates Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Ketley & Oakengates compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.





- The proportion of people aged 25-64 and 65-84 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is worse than the borough and England average. For women, it is better than the Telford & Wrekin and England average.
- Ketley & Oakengates is ranked in the second worst fifth wards in the borough for deprivation. The level of income deprivation in the ward is significantly worse worse than the average for England.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for all causes, coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is significantly worse than the Telford & Wrekin and England average.
- The rate of hospital admissions for self harm and alcohol related harm is also significantly worse than the England average. The rate for alcohol related harm is the third worst in the borough.




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Population age profile


Starting Well

Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies in Ketley & Oakengates (6.6%) is better than the borough and England average.
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (20.6%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.


The percentage of mothers breastfeeding at birth (64.5%) is similar to the borough average but worse than the England average.

The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (29.0%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity


The level of obesity among children in reception year (13.0%) and year 6 (27.5%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (18.5%) is estimated to be similar to the borough and statistically similar to the England average.
- The level of adult obesity (27.5%) and healthy eating (21.9%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



Smoking cessation

The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (54%) is similar to the borough average (56%).




Ageing Well

Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (7.8%) and long term illnesses or disability (21.9%) is worse than the borough and England average.

The proportion of people in Ketley & Oakengates who provide unpaid care for 1 hour or more (12.1%) and 50 hours or more (3.6%) per week is worse than the borough and England average.





Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Ketley & Oakengates is similar to the borough and England average for deaths from coronary heart disease.
- The ratio is worse than the borough and England average for:
 - · deaths from all causes
 - · deaths from all cancers
 - · deaths from circulatory disease

Ketley & Oakengates is ranked in the worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in the ward (124.1) is the ninth worst in the borough and compares with the borough average of 111.6 and the best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin of 60.9.
