
# Ward Health Profile 2014: Malinslee

#### Overview

• The health of people who live in Malinslee Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Malinslee compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.





- The proportion of people aged under 16 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is worse than the borough and England average. For women, it is similar to the borough and worse than the England average.
- Malinslee is one of the most deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England. One third of people in the ward live in income deprived households, and more than four in ten children under 16 years are classed as living in poverty.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions is significantly worse than the England average for all causes, coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.
- •The rate of hospital stays for self harm and alcohol related harm is also significantly worse than the England average. The rate for alcohol related harm is the second worst in the borough.




#### Starting Well

#### **Pregnancy and Maternity**


The proportion of mothers smoking at the time of delivery (30.0%) and low birth weight babies (9.4%) is worse than the borough and England average.

The proportion of mothers in Malinslee breastfeeding at birth (52.0%) and at 6-8 weeks (25.5%) is worse than the borough and England average.



#### Childhood obesity


- The level of obesity in year 6 children (18.5%) is better than the borough and England average.
- Obesity in reception year children (10.1%) is similar to the borough and worse than the England average.

## Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (19.1%) is estimated to be similar to the borough and England average.
- The level of adult obesity (30.4%) and healthy eating (17.6%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



## **Smoking cessation**

The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (60%) is better than the borough average (56%).



#### Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (8.7%) and long term illnesses or disability (22.3%) is worse than the average for the borough and England

The proportion of people in Malinslee who provide 1 hour or more 11.1%) and 50 hours or more (3.9%) unpaid care per week is worse than the average for the borough and England




## Early deaths


- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 from all cancers in Malinslee is similar to the England average.
- The ratio is worse than the borough average and significantly worse than the England average for:
  - · deaths from all causes
  - · deaths from circulatory disease
  - · deaths from heart disease

Malinslee is ranked in the worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Malinslee (132.7) is the sixth worst in the borough and compares with the borough average of 111.6, the best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin of 60.9 and the England average of 100.

The ratio of early deaths from circulatory disease (163.2) is the third worst in the borough.
