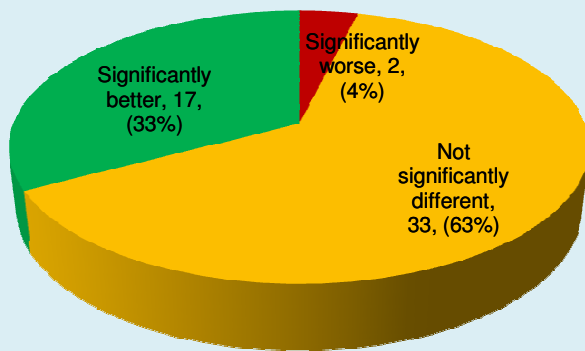


Ward Health Profile 2014: Muxton

Overview

• The health of people who live in Muxton Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Muxton compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



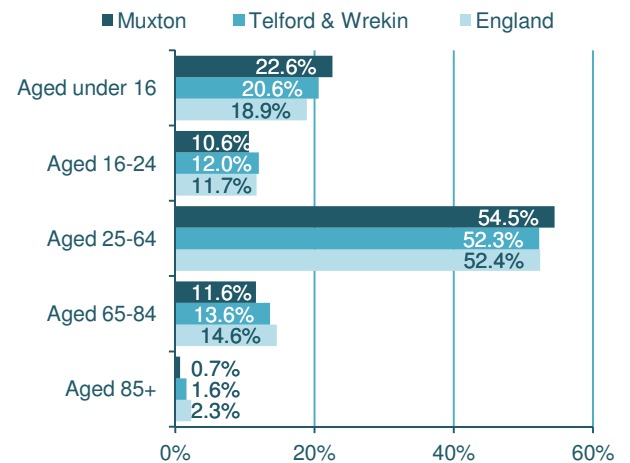

- The proportion of people aged under 16 and 25-64 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin. For women, it is better than the borough and England average.
- Muxton is one of the least deprived wards in the borough. Levels of income deprivation, child poverty and older people living in deprivation in the ward are significantly better than the average for England.
- Emergency hospital admission rates for all causes and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease are significantly better than the England average.
- The admission rate for self harm and alcohol related harm is also significantly better in Muxton than the England average.

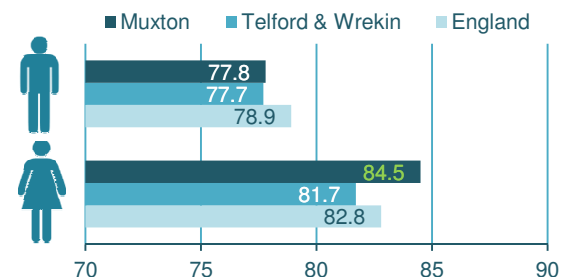


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Population age profile



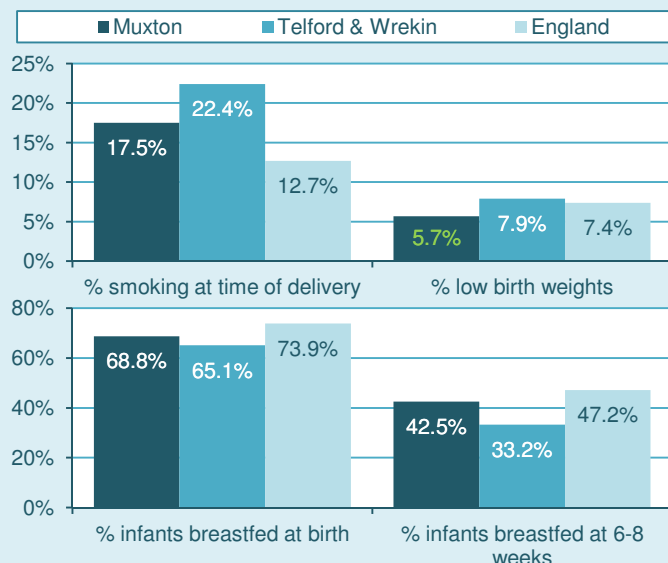

Starting Well

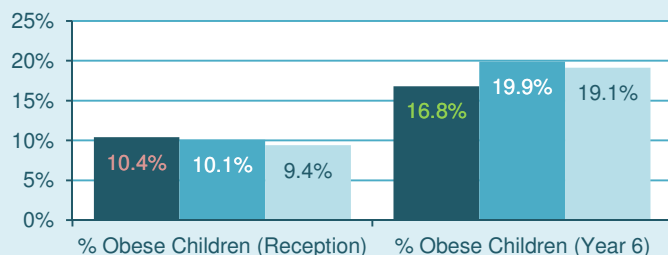
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies in Muxton (5.7%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (17.5%), breastfeeding at birth (68.8%) and at 6-8 weeks (42.5%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.



Childhood obesity

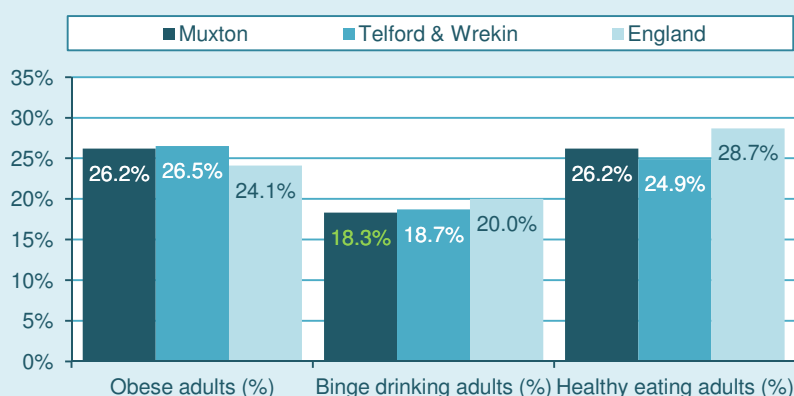
- The level of obesity in year 6 children (16.8%) is better than the borough and England average.
- The level of obesity in reception year children (10.4%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The proportion of adults who binge drink (18.3%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.
- The level of adult obesity (26.2%) and healthy eating (26.2%) is estimated to be better than the borough and worse than the England average.



Smoking cessation

- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (56%) is similar to the borough average (56%).

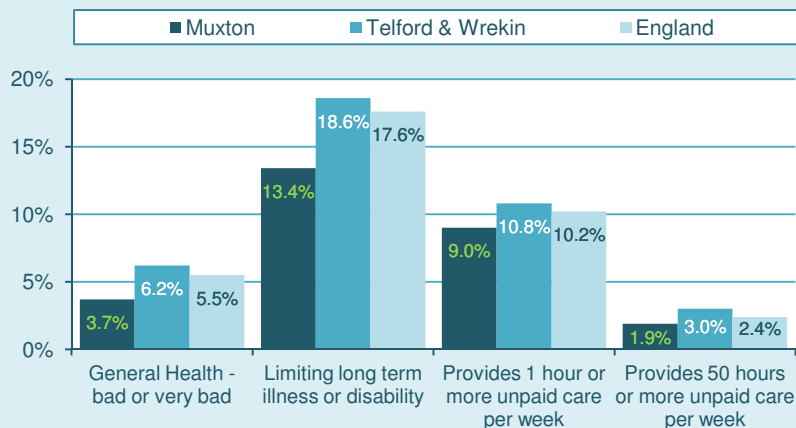

Health and Care

● The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (3.7%) and long term illnesses or disability (13.4) is better than the borough and England average.

The proportion of people in Muxton who provide 1 hour or more (9.0%) and 50 hours or more (1.9%) unpaid care per week is better than the borough and England average.



Early deaths

● The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Muxton is better than the borough and England average for:

- deaths from all causes
- deaths from all cancers

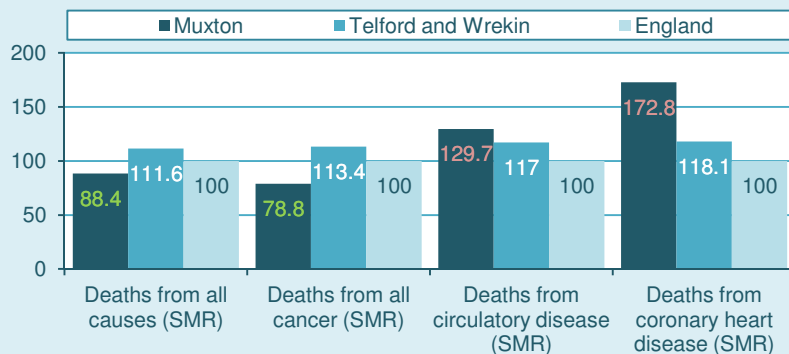
● The ratio is worse than the borough and England average for:

- deaths from circulatory disease
- deaths from heart disease

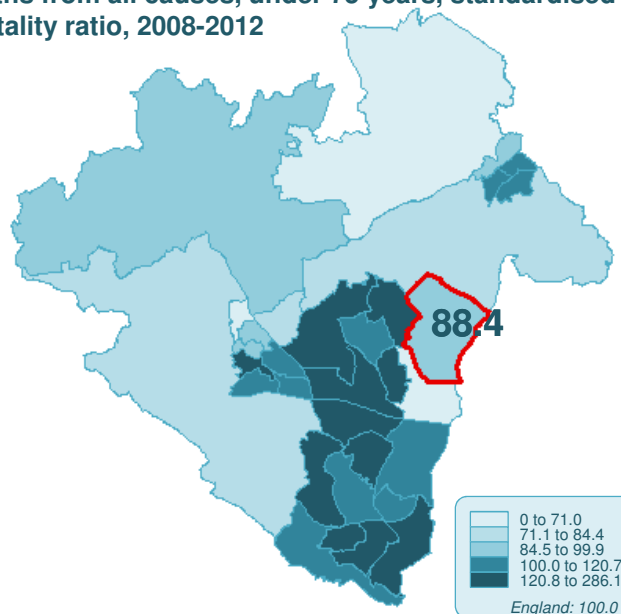
Muxton is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Muxton (88.4) is the seventh best in the borough and compares with the borough average of 111.6, the best ward ratio in Telford & Wrekin of 60.9.

The ratio of early deaths from all cancers (78.8) is the fifth best in Telford & Wrekin, whilst the ratio of early deaths from heart disease (172.8) is the fifth worst.



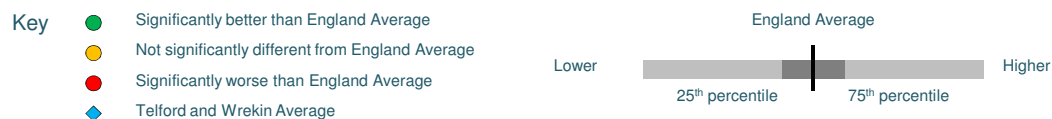
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
