
# Ward Health Profile 2014: Newport East

#### Overview

• The health of people who live in Newport East Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Newport East compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.




- The proportion of people aged 16-24 and 65-84 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men and women is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin.
- •.Newport East is one of the less deprived wards in the borough. Levels of income deprivation and the proportion of children under 16 living in poverty in Newport East are significantly better than the England average.
- The emergency hospital admission rate for all causes and for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is better than the England average. The admission rate for all causes is the sixth best in the borough and the seventh best for COPD.
- The rate of hospital admissions for alcohol related harm in Newport East is better than the England average and is the fourth best rate in Telford & Wrekin.




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### Population age profile




# Starting Well

# Pregnancy and Maternity


The proportion of mothers smoking at the time of delivery (12.5%) and breastfeeding their babies at birth (93.8%) and at 6-8 weeks (47.6%) is better than the borough and the England average.

The proportion of low birth weight babies (5.9%) in Newport East is also better than the borough and the England average.

Obesity in year 6 children (22.7%) is worse than the borough and England average.



# Adult lifestyle

The level of binge drinking (18.3%) and healthy eating (29.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough average and better the England average.

The proportion of adults who are obese (23.7%) is estimated to be better than the borough average and similar to the England average



# **Smoking cessation**

The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (60%) is better than the borough average (56%).




# Ageing Well

#### Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (5.1%) and long term illnesses or disability (17.2%) is better than the borough average and similar to the England average.

The proportion of people who provide unpaid care for 1 hour or more (10.1%) and 50 hours or more (2.7%) unpaid care per week is also better than the borough average and similar to the England average.




### Early deaths


- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Newport East is similar to the borough average and statistically similar to the England average for deaths from all causes and all cancers.
- The ratio of deaths from circulatory disease and coronary heart disease is worse than the borough and England average.

Newport East is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Newport East (115.5) is the twelfth worst out of the 33 wards in the borough. This compares to the Telford & Wrekin average (111.6) and the best ward ratio in the borough (60.9)

The ratio of early deaths from coronary heart disease (225.7) is the second worst in the borough.
