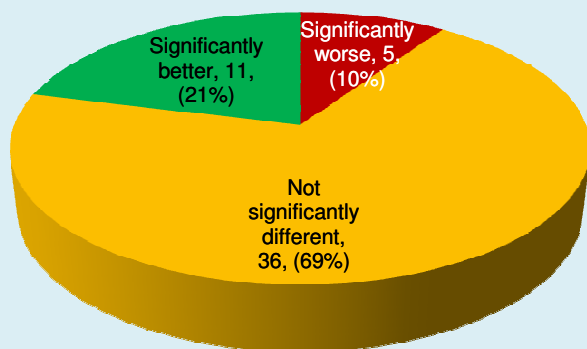


Ward Health Profile 2014: Newport North

Overview

• The health of people who live in Newport North Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Newport North compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.

• The proportion of people aged 65-84 and 85 plus in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.

• Life expectancy for men is similar to the borough average. For women, it is worse than the borough average and significantly worse than the average for England.

• Newport North is one of the least deprived wards in the borough. Levels of income deprivation and the proportion of children under 16 living in poverty in the ward are significantly better than the average for England.

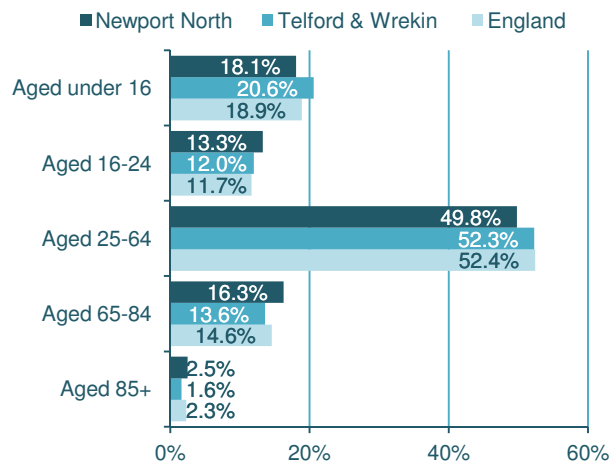
• The rate of emergency hospital admissions for all causes and for chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is better than the England average. The admission rate for all causes is the seventh best in the borough and the eighth best for COPD.

• The rate of hospital admissions for alcohol related harm in Newport North is better than the England average.

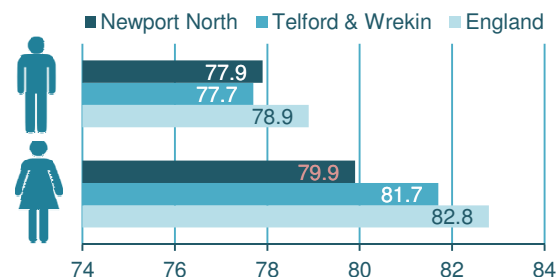


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Population age profile



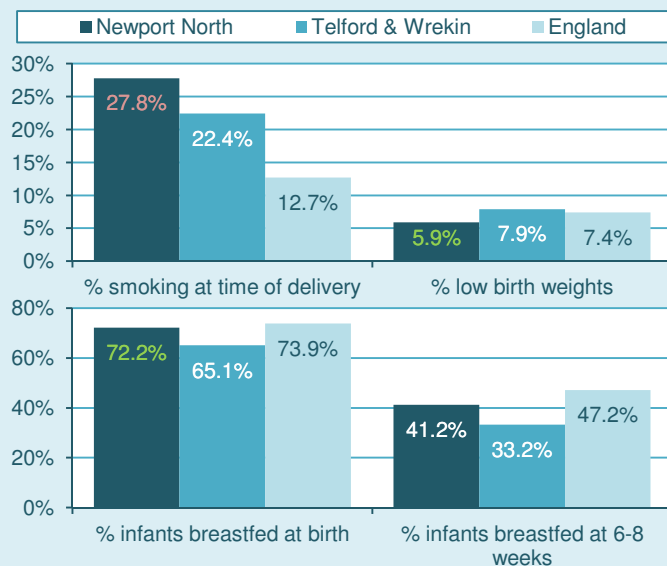

Starting Well

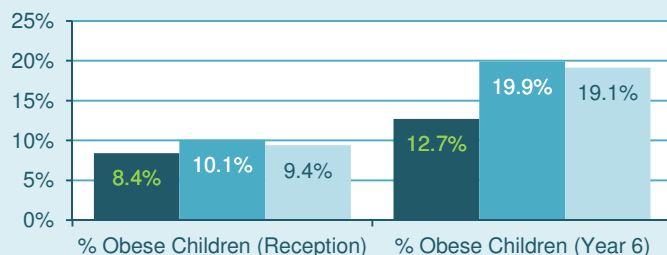
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies (5.9%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at birth (72.2%) is better than the borough average and similar to the England average.
- The proportion breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (41.2%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.
- The proportion of mothers who smoke at time of delivery (27.8%) is worse than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity

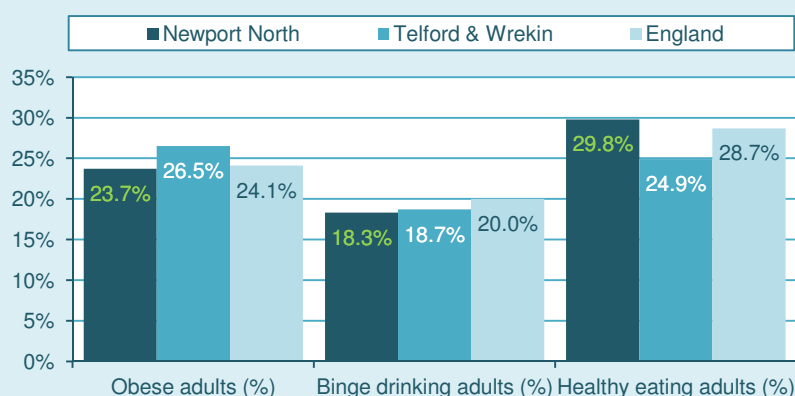
- The proportion of obese children in reception year (8.4%) and year 6 (12.7%) is better than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The proportion of adults who binge drink (18.3%), who are obese (23.7%) and who eat healthily (29.8%) is estimated to be better than the borough and the England average.



Smoking cessation

- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (63%) is better than the borough average (56%).

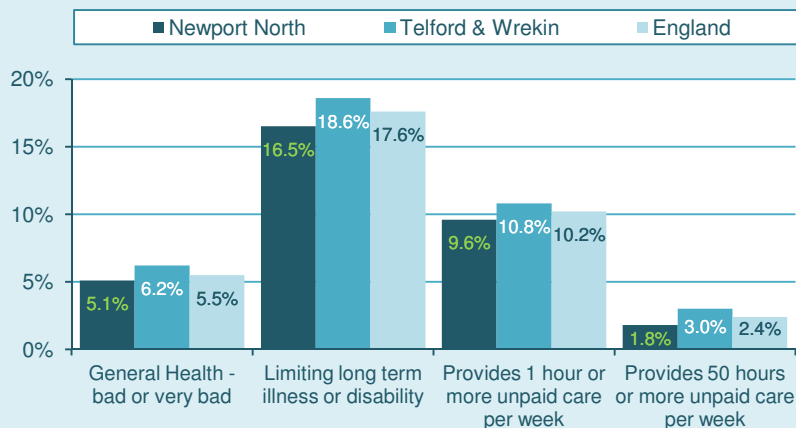

Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (5.1%) and long term illnesses or disability (16.5%) is better in Newport North than the borough and England average.

The proportion of people who provide unpaid care for 1 hour or more (9.6%) and 50 hours or more (1.6%) per week is better than the borough and the England average.



Early deaths

The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Newport North is better than the borough and England average for:

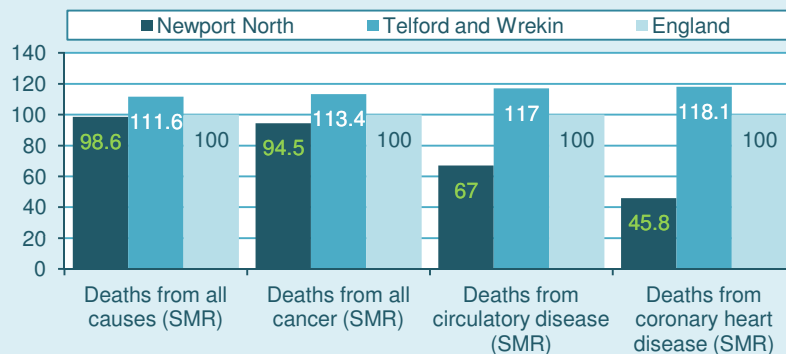
- deaths from all cancers
- deaths from circulatory disease
- deaths from heart disease

The ratio of deaths from all causes is better than the borough average and similar to the average for England.

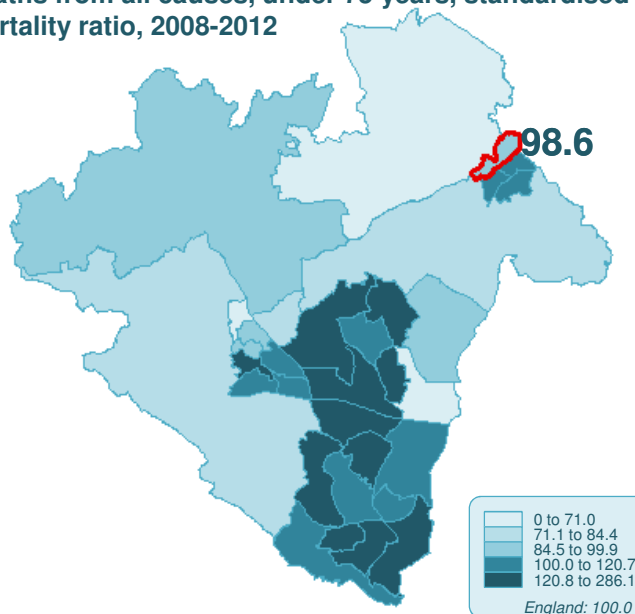
Newport North is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Newport North (98.6) is the tenth best of the 33 wards in the borough. This compares to the Telford & Wrekin average of 111.6 and the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9.

The ratio of early deaths from coronary heart disease (45.8) is the third best in the borough.



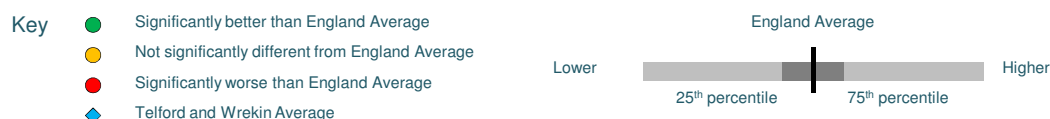
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
