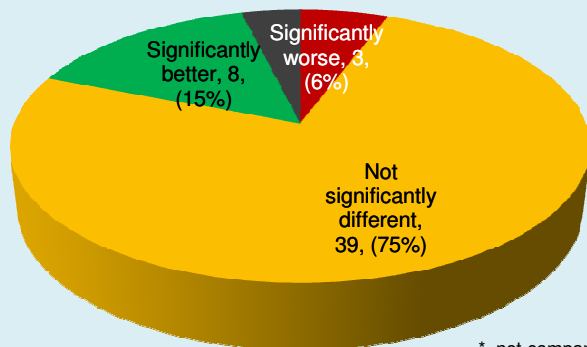


# Ward Health Profile 2014: Park

## Overview

- The health of people who live in Park Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Park compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



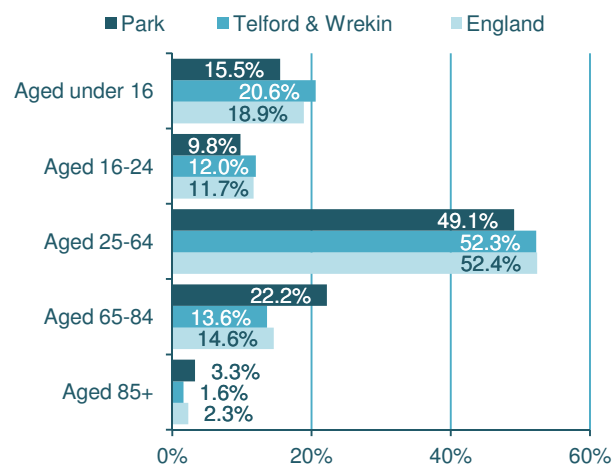

- The proportion of people aged 65-84 and 85 plus in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women, it is similar to the average for the borough and for England.
- The level of income deprivation, proportion of children under 16 living in poverty and proportion of older people living in deprivation in Park is significantly better than the average for England.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for all causes, coronary heart disease, stroke, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is similar to the average for England.
- The rate of hospital admissions for self harm and alcohol related harm is significantly better than the England average. The admission rate for self harm is the joint third best in the borough.

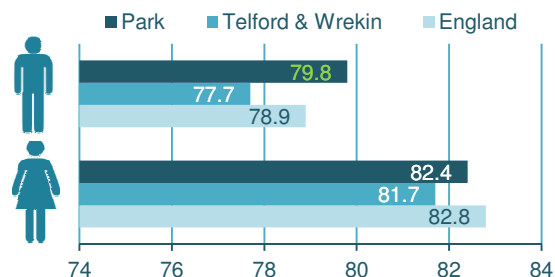


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## Population age profile



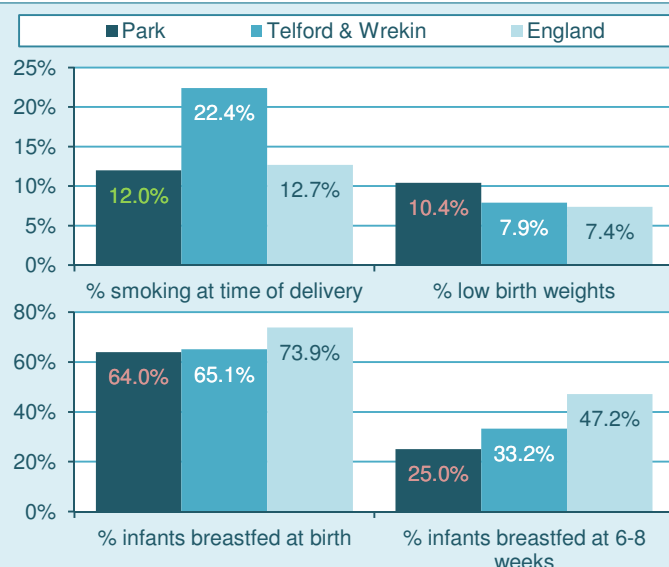

## Starting Well

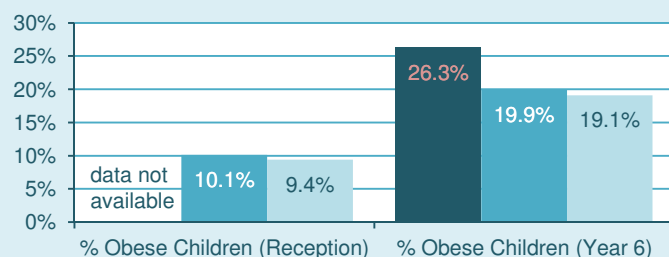
### Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion mothers smoking at time of delivery (12.0%) is better in Park than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of low birth weight babies (10.4%) and mothers breastfeeding at birth (64.0%) and at 6-8 weeks (25.0%) is worse than the borough and England average.



### Childhood obesity

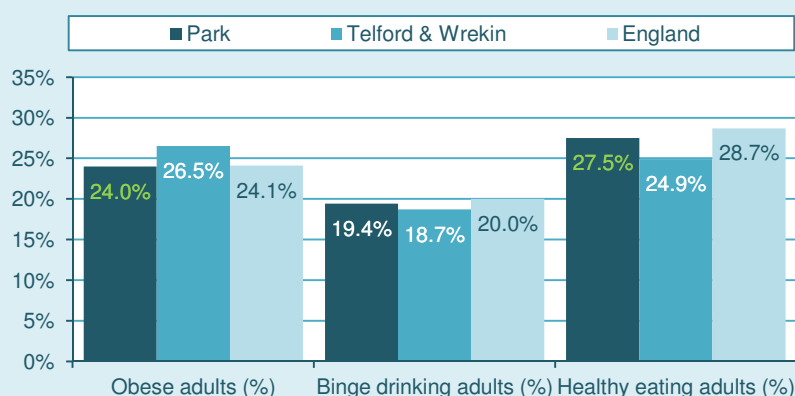
- The proportion of year 6 children classed as obese (26.3%) in Park is worse than the borough and England average.



## Living Well

### Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult obesity (24.0%) and healthy eating (27.5%) is estimated to be better than the borough average and similar to the England average.
- The proportion of adults who binge drink (19.4%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and similar to the England average.



### Smoking cessation

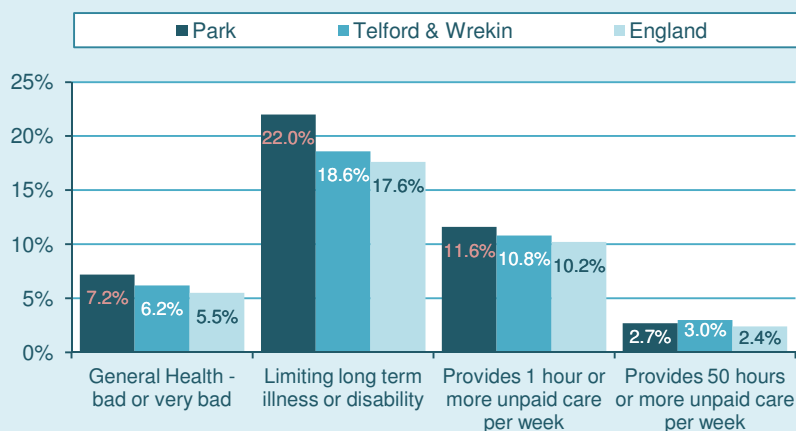
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (50%) is worse than the borough average (56%).

## Health and Care

- The proportion of people providing 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (2.7%) is similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (97.2%), long term illnesses or disability (22.0%) and providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (11.6%) is worse than the borough and England average.

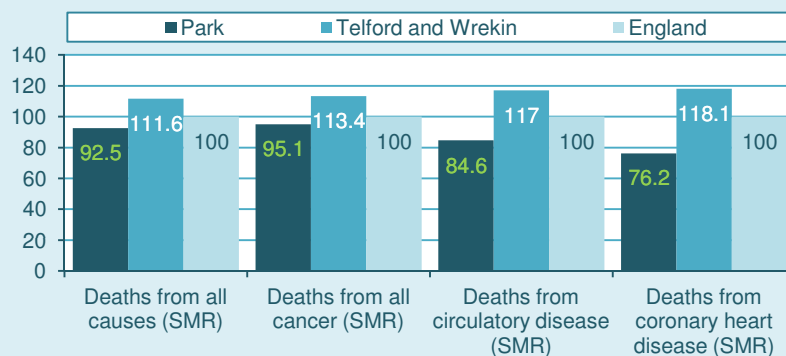


## Early deaths

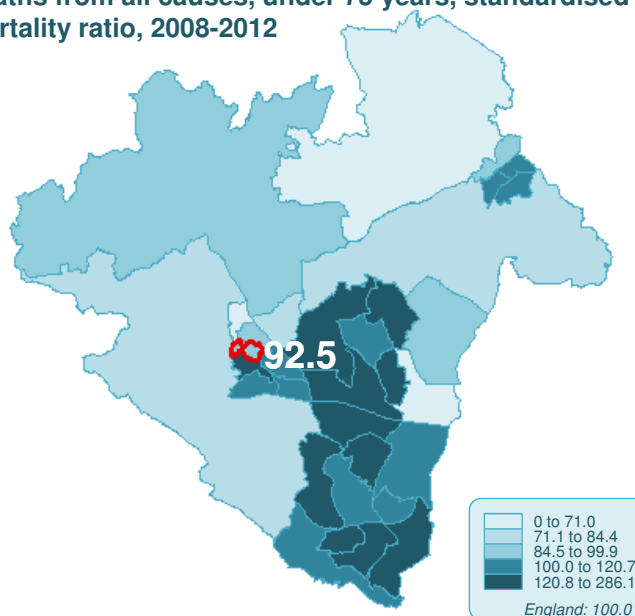
- The ratio of deaths among people aged under 75 in Park is better than the borough and England average for:
  - deaths from all causes
  - deaths from all cancers
  - deaths from circulatory disease
  - deaths from heart disease

Park is ranked in middle fifth of wards in England for deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Park (92.5) is the eighth best of the 33 wards in the borough and compares to the Telford & Wrekin average of 111.6 and the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9.



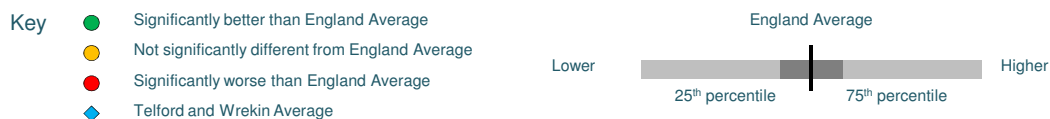
### Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
