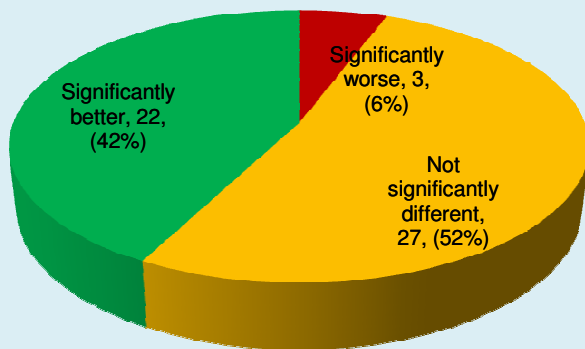


# Ward Health Profile 2014: Priorslee

## Overview

• The health of people who live in Priorslee Ward is generally better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how Priorslee compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



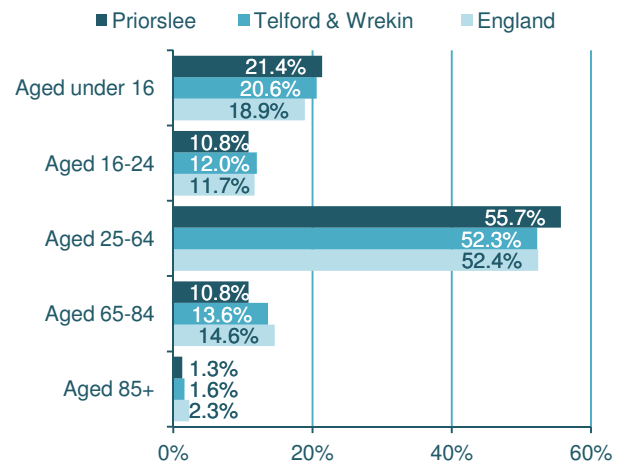

- The proportion of people aged 25-64 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is better than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women, it is worse than the borough and England average.
- Priorslee is one of the least deprived wards in the borough. The level of income deprivation, proportion of children under 16 living in poverty and proportion of older people in deprivation in the ward is significantly better than the average for England.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for all causes, coronary heart disease and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is better than the England average. The admission rate for both heart disease and COPD is the best in the borough.
- The hospital admission rate for self harm and alcohol related harm is better than the England average. The admission rate for alcohol related harm in Priorslee is the best in Telford & Wrekin.

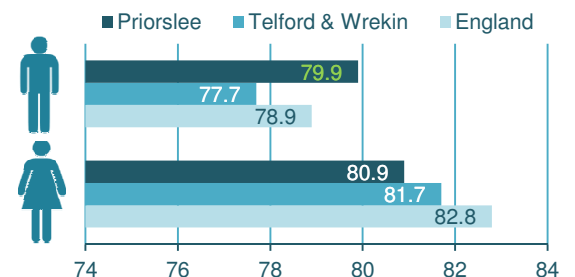

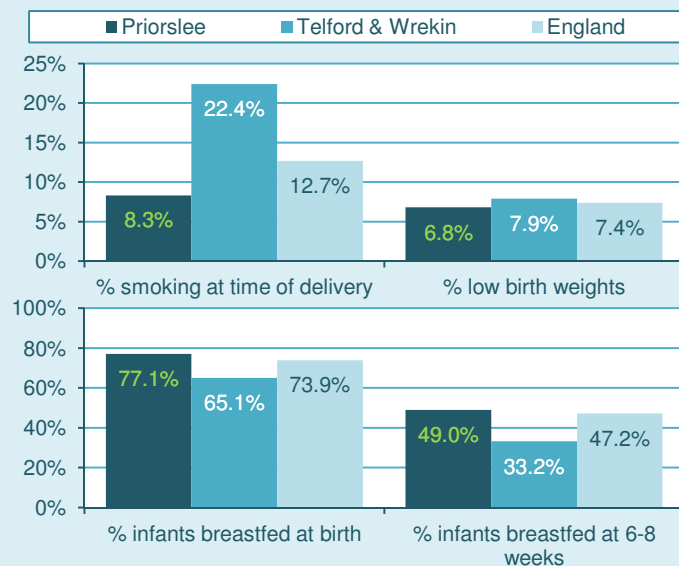


## Starting Well

### Pregnancy and Maternity

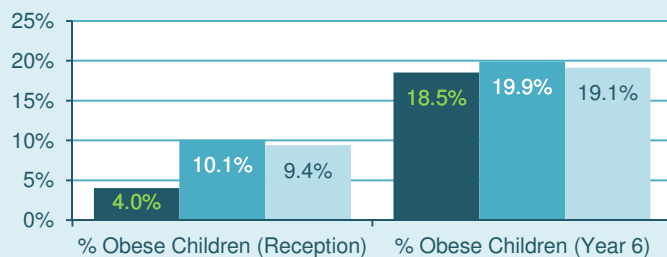
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (8.3%) and low birth weight babies (6.8%) is better in Priorslee than the average for the borough and England

The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at birth (77.1%) and at 6-8 weeks (49.0%) is also better than the average for the borough and England.



### Childhood obesity

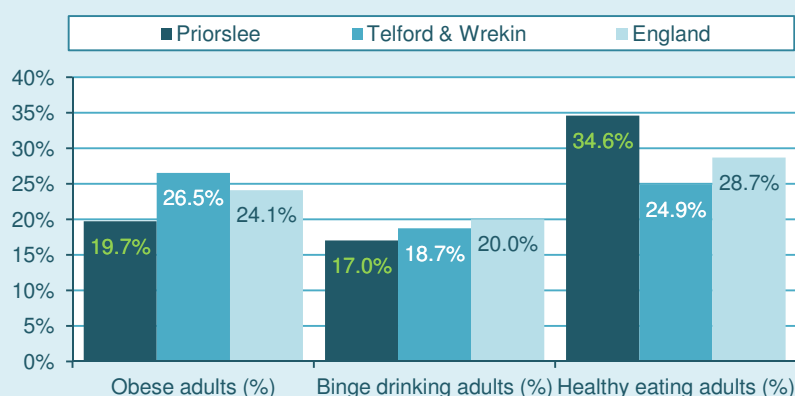
- The proportion of children in reception year (4.0%) and year 6 (18.5%) classed as obese in Priorslee is better than the borough and England average.



## Living Well

### Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult obesity (19.7%), binge drinking (17.0%) and healthy eating (34.6%) is estimated to be better than the borough and England average.



### Smoking cessation

- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (70%) is better than the borough average (56%).

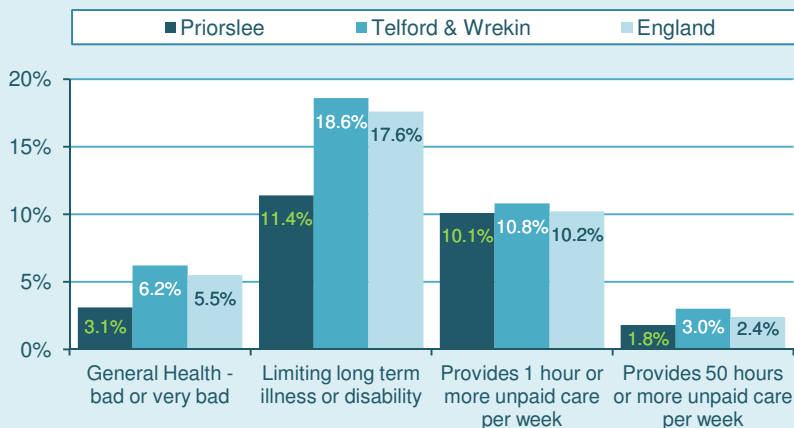

### Health and Care

The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (3.1%), long term illnesses or disability (11.4%) and who provide 50 hours or more (1.8%) unpaid care per week is better than the borough and better the England average.

The proportion who provide 1 hour or more unpaid care per week (10.1%) is better than the borough average and similar to the England average.



### Early deaths

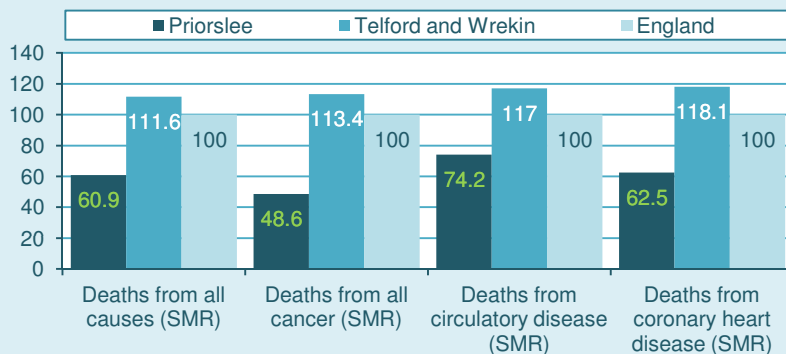
The ratio of deaths among people under the age of 75 in Priorslee is better than the borough average and the England average for:

- deaths from all causes
- deaths from all cancers
- deaths from circulatory disease
- deaths from heart disease

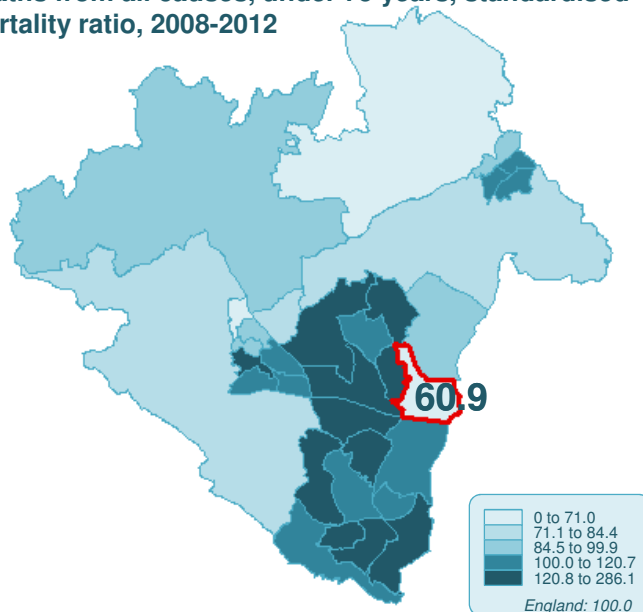
Priorslee is ranked in the best fifth of wards in England for the ratio of early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in Priorslee (60.9) is the best ratio of the 33 wards in the borough and compares to the Telford & Wrekin average of 111.6.

The ratio of early deaths from all cancer (48.6) is the second best ratio in Telford & Wrekin.



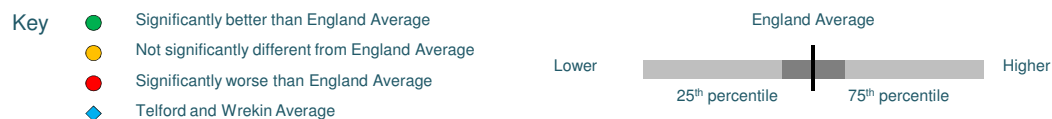
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
