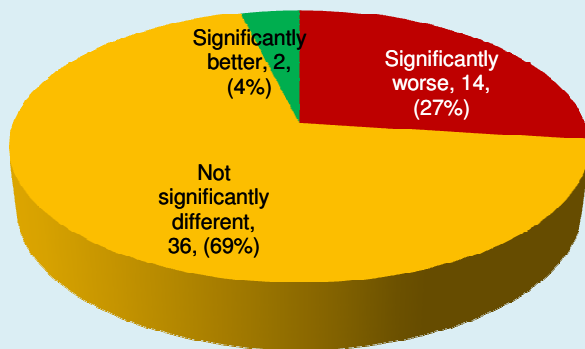


Ward Health Profile 2014: St Georges

Overview

• The health of people who live in St Georges Ward is generally worse compared to the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how St Georges compares with England across 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.



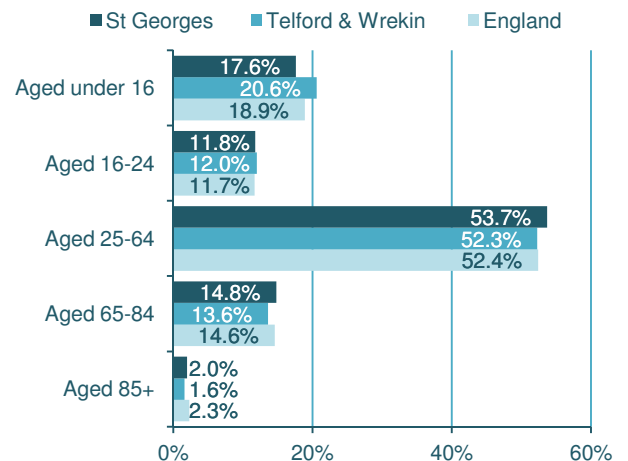

- The proportion of people aged under 16 in the ward is lower than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and is significantly worse than the average for England.
- Life expectancy for women is better than the borough and the England average.
- St Georges is ranked in the middle fifth of wards in the borough for deprivation. Levels of income deprivation are better than the borough average and only slightly worse than the England average. A smaller proportion of children in the ward live in poverty compared to the borough and England average.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for coronary heart disease, heart attack and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease is significantly worse than the average for England.
- The emergency admission rate for heart attack is the worst in the borough.

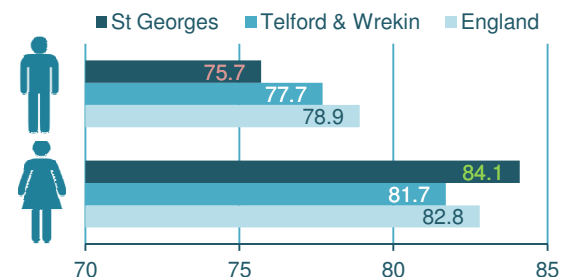


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Population age profile



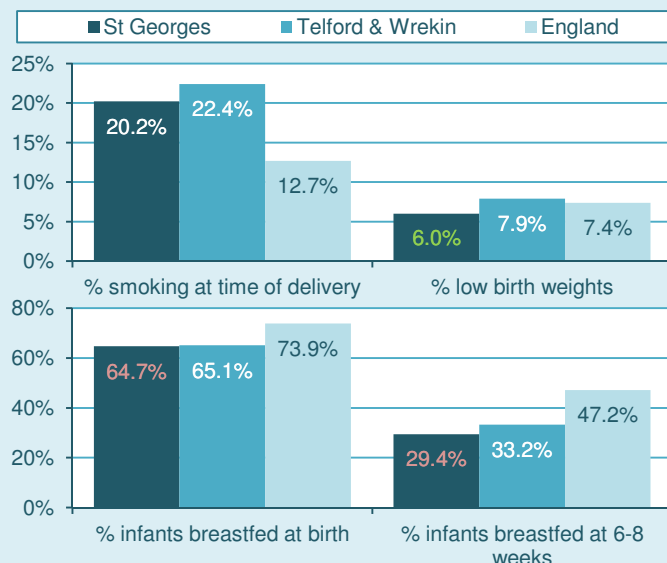

Starting Well

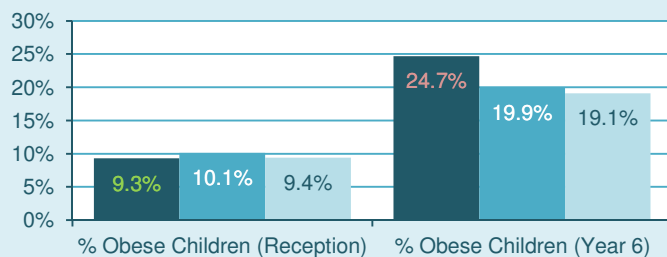
Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies in St Georges (6.0%) is better than the borough and the England average.
- The proportion of mothers smoking at time of delivery (20.2%) is better than the borough average but worse than the England average.
- The proportion of mothers breastfeeding at birth (64.7%) and at 6-8 weeks (29.4%) is worse than the borough and the England average.



Childhood obesity

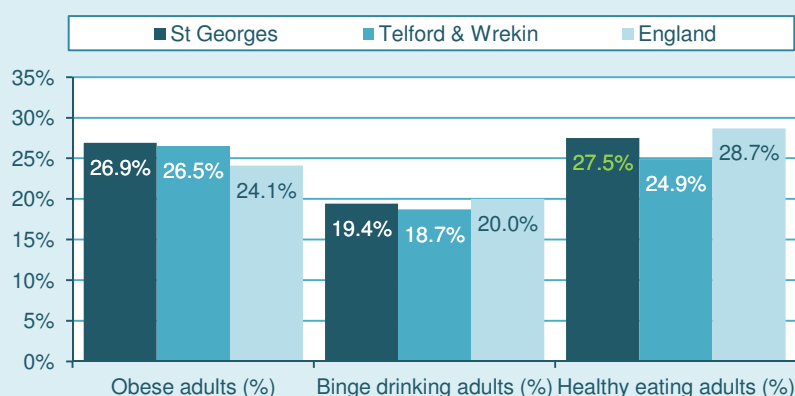
- Obesity levels in reception year children (9.3%) are better than the borough average and similar to the England average.
- Year 6 obesity levels (24.7%) are worse than the borough and national average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of healthy eating (27.5%) is estimated to be better than the borough average and similar to the England average.
- The proportion of adults who are obese (26.9%) and who binge drink (19.4%) is estimated to be similar to the borough and the England average.



Smoking cessation

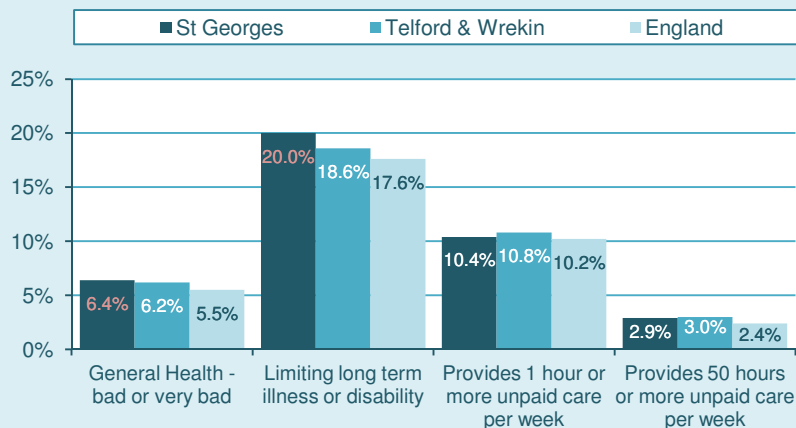
- The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 and August 2014 (70%), is better than the borough average (56%).

Health and Care

- The proportion of people who provide 1 hour or more and 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (10.4% and 2.9%) is better than the average for the borough but worse than the average for England.
- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (6.4%) and limiting long term illness or disability (20.0%) is worse than the borough and England average.

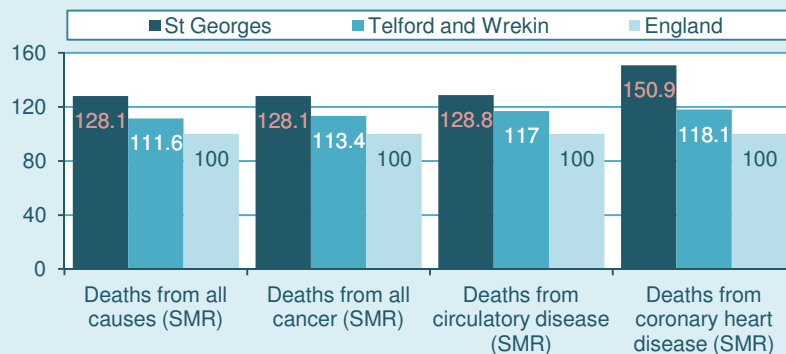


Early deaths

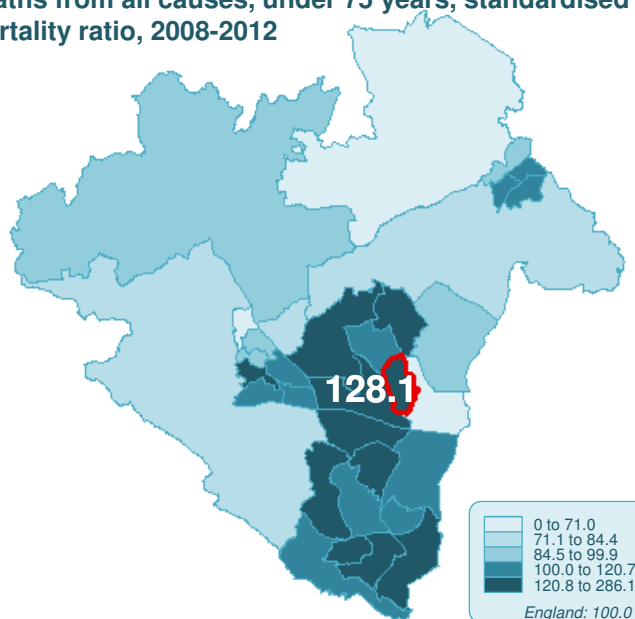
- The ratio of deaths amongst people aged under 75 in St Georges is worse than the borough and the England average for:
 - deaths from all causes
 - deaths from all cancers
 - deaths from circulatory disease
 - deaths from heart disease

St Georges is ranked in the worst fifth of wards in England for the ratio of early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths in St Georges ward (128.1) is the eighth worst in the borough and compares with the average ratio for Telford & Wrekin of 111.6, the best ward ratio in the borough of 60.9 and the England average of 100.



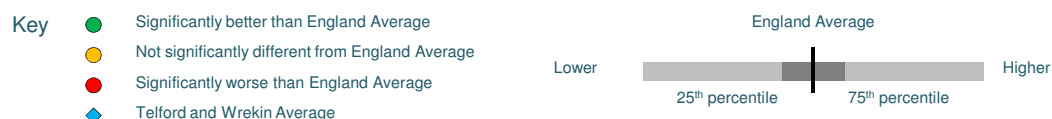
Deaths from all causes, under 75 years, standardised mortality ratio, 2008-2012
