
Ward Health Profile 2014: The Nedge

Overview

• The health of people who live in The Nedge Ward is generally worse than the average for Telford & Wrekin and England as a whole. The chart below summarises how The Nedge compares with England in 52 Public Health England Local Health Indicators.




- The proportion of people aged under 16 and 25-64 in the ward is higher than the average for Telford & Wrekin and for England.
- Life expectancy for men is similar to the average for Telford & Wrekin and England. For women, it is better than the borough average and similar to the average for England.
- The Nedge is ranked among the more deprived wards in the borough. Levels of deprivation in the ward are significantly worse than the average for England. One fifth of people in the ward live in income deprived households, and more than one quarter of children under 16 years live in poverty.
- The rate of emergency hospital admissions for heart attack and coronary heart disease are significantly worse than the England average.
- The rate of hospital admissions for alcohol related harm is significantly better than the England average.








Starting Well


Pregnancy and Maternity

- The proportion of low birth weight babies (8.1%) is similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion mothers smoking at time of delivery (30.0%), breastfeeding at birth (55.0%) and breastfeeding at 6-8 weeks (26.5%) is worse in The Nedge than the borough and England average.



Childhood obesity


Obesity levels in reception year (7.7%) and year 6 (17.9%) children in The Nedge are better than the borough and England average.



Living Well

Adult lifestyle

- The level of adult binge drinking (18.8%) is estimated to be similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion of adults who are obese (29.0%) and who eat healthily (23.1%) is estimated to be worse than the borough and England average.



Smoking cessation


The successful quit rate for adult smokers engaged in the stop smoking programme in the 12 months since September 2013 (59%) is better than the borough average (56%).



Ageing Well

Health and Care

- The proportion of people reporting bad or very bad health (5.8%), long term illnesses or disability (17.8%) and providing 1 hour or more unpaid care per week is similar to the borough and England average.
- The proportion of people who provide 50 hours or more unpaid care per week (3.4%) is worse than the borough and England average.





Early deaths

- The ratio of deaths from coronary heart disease among people aged under 75 in The Nedge is better than the borough and England average.
- The ratio of early deaths from all causes and from circulatory disease is similar to the borough and England average.
- The ratio of deaths from all cancers is worse than the borough and England average.

The Nedge is ranked in the second worst fifth of wards in England for early deaths from all causes.

The ratio of early deaths from all causes in The Nedge (110.7) ranks the ward in the middle of the 33 wards in the borough, compared to the Telford & Wrekin average (111.6) and the best ward ratio in the borough (60.9).
