

**TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL
(HORTON LANE) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
ORDER 2017**

Borough of Telford and Wrekin in exercise of the powers under Sections 1 (1), 2 (1), 2(2) and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make an Order the effect will be to:

1. Prohibit all motor vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Horton Lane as it extends from the junction of Hortonwood 60 for a distance of 20 metres in a northwest direction.

2. Exemptions will be provided in the Order for emergency vehicles.
