I see from the recent TWLP , that while you still talk about 'sustainability', 'green space', 'health & fitness' , that you actually don't mean to do anything about protecting and/or promoting these values.

As a resident of Lawley Village, I am greatly saddened and hugely disappointed, as so many of us are that live here, that you insist on building more housing in an already over developed Lawley.

There are constant problems with parking, as existing new housing hasn't been insufficient allocated parking, many family houses of 4 or more bedrooms , have 1 parking space which is on the road or directly in front of their house under a window, on a integral estate road that allows 1 car to drive down!

Traffic is increasing and causes regular problem by Lawley Primary school, littering is disgusting and increasing.

The Doctors are over stretched and it is difficult to get an appointment (or even a return phone call) within 2 weeks ,more usually 3weeks, regardless of serious health conditions.

The green space is rapidly decreasing, so wildlife, health benefits of seeing and walking through green space will be limited to a few trees outside your window!

Shouldn't we be encouraging people to use green space better, improve mental health and ever expanding waistlines, encouraging our children to enjoy the space and walk or cycle instead of using lifts from mum & dad's car?

As for the local shopping centre in Lawley, still has empty units, the most recent has been taken by a 'tanning salon' , really ! is that the best we can do ? try reading the 'Community' pages on Facebook to see what locals want and need in the area, a nice community, with a central point for meeting, and getting basic shopping, a coffee , somewhere to walk with family, dogs, have a picnic.

I also noted in 'The Plan" the 'ha' and allocated housing, confused as to why H10 has 34.895ha with housing of 300 and H17 has 13.82ha and housing of 250, how does that work? more squashed housing with no parking and difficult access ? oh and maybe you are going to dig up the woodland as well!
