Waters Upton Parish Council would like to express concern that there is limited protection for the rural parishes with the removal of the policy against 'development in the open countryside'.

We would also like to bring to the attention of the Inspector, the Waters Upton Neighbourhood Plan, as this has been confirmed through the recommended process and should work alongside the TWC Local Plan with regards to development in Waters Upton Parish.

The Parish Council continues to have concerns, as one of the five named settlements suitable for development in the rural area, in that IF either the Dairy Crest, Crudgington or Allscot applications do not bring forward the number of proposed dwellings that Waters Upton, with the other four named settlements, will be seen as appropriate to take up the additional housing numbers. It is our request that it be included in the Local Plan that the five named rural settlements will not be expected to take more houses if those two brown field sites do not come forward.
