### Improvements in Your Area

We will shortly be working in your area as part of our 'Pride in Our Community' investment programme. Over the next three years an additional £45 million will be invested into improving the Borough's roads, pavements, street lights and structures. This includes the installation of energy efficient street lights and road signs, a programme of road lining improvement as well as additional investment in repairing local roads and paths and environmental maintenance.

We will be carrying out a resurfacing scheme to improve the condition of the carriageway on Gower Street, St Georges. The work is due to start on the 12<sup>th</sup> February for preparatory works using temporary traffic signals. A full road closure will be in place from the 18<sup>th</sup> February for resurfacing works. The closure will be in place 24hrs a day for one week, **weather permitting** to complete the scheme. Works are being undertaken during the school half term to reduce the impact on highway users. Gower Street will be closed for the duration of the scheme, with a full diversion in place around the site.

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded to allow the surfacing material to harden. **Details about specific local roads affected can be found overleaf.**

We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works. If you have any special access requirements while the works are in progress, please let us know prior to work starting or alternatively let the site operatives know on site.

Telford & Wrekin Services Ltd will shortly be working on Gower Street on behalf of Telford & Wrekin Council.



The work will involve resurfacing the carriageway and we anticipate the scheme will commence on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2017 for just over 2 weeks, although these dates are weather permitting.

To complete these essential works it will be necessary to close Gower Street for the duration of the half term week (18<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> February), with a full diversion in place around the site.

Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.
