STATEMENT OF REASONS

TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL EDGMOND VILLAGE (VARIOUS ROADS) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

Proposals

The Council has recently undertaken a review of the 30mph speed limit in Edgmond following a request from the Parish Council. As part of this review it was noted that there was an inconsistency in the way the current speed limit is displayed through parts of the village, there was also part of the current 30mph speed limit Order which dates back to 1961 and needs to be updated due to changes in the position of signage.

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The speed limit Order is being made as it appears to the highway authority that it is expedient to make it -

- for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or
- for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
