TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL (B5063 WALTON TO HIGH ERCALL, TELFORD) (SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

Borough of Telford and Wrekin in exercise of their powers under Sections 82, 83 and 84, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order: -

- 2. The Borough of Telford and Wrekin, Walton Village. 30mph Speed Limit Order 2004 is hereby revoked in its entirety.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in Schedule One to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only, on the attached plan.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule Two to this Order and as shown for identification purposes only, on the attached plan.
- 5. The provisions of Article 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for ambulance service, fire service, or police purposes if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose which it is being used on that occasion.
- 6. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

SCHEDULE ONE (30mph Speed Limit)		
1	Shropshire Boundary to Coppice Drive, Walton	From a point 354m west of the junction with Penmarsh Lane, Walton, to a point 270m south of the junction with Crabtree Lane, Walton.
SCHEDULE TWO		
(40mph Speed Limit)		
2	Shropshire Boundary to Coppice Drive, Walton	From a point 270m south of the junction with Crabtree Lane, Walton, to a point 20m north of its junction with Coppice Drive, High Ercall.
