Improvements in Your Area: St Georges Ward

We will shortly be working in your area as part of our 'Pride in Our Community' investment programme. Between 2017 and 2019 an additional £45 million is being invested in improving the Borough's roads, pavements, street lights and structures. This includes the installation of energy efficient street lights and road signs and a programme of road lining improvements. A list of all highway and transport schemes to be delivered in your area over the next 12 months can be found at the end of this letter.

We will be resurfacing Fenns Crescent to improve the condition of the highway in this area. The work is due to start on the 23rd July for two weeks, **weather permitting**. To complete the work we will need to close the road between 08:00 – 18:00, Monday to Friday throughout the week. No works will be undertaken over the weekend.

Access will always be available for emergency services and residents, however we kindly request that car movements between the hours of 08:30 and 16:30 are kept to a minimum. To enable us to complete works as quickly as possible, we would appreciate it if all cars could be moved outside of the closure before 8:30. If this is not possible then please allow some time for contractors to escort you through the works when it is safe to do so when you plan a journey. Please be aware that we may also need you to move your vehicle at short notice during the day to allow works to be completed.

We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works. If you have any special access requirements while the works are in progress, please let the site operatives know.

Telford & Wrekin Services Ltd will shortly be working in Fenns Crescent on behalf of Telford & Wrekin Council.

We will be resurfacing the carriageway to improve the condition of the surface. We anticipate the works will commence on 23rd July 2018 for two weeks.

We will be working between 08:00 – 18:00hrs, to complete these essential works it will be necessary to close the road. Access to properties will be maintained at all times throughout the works but may be restricted for short periods. We will have people on hand to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do so.

Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised when near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.
