The Newport Neighbourhood Development Plan has been developed by the Town Council to establish a long term view for the Newport area and help deliver the local community's aspirations and needs for the plan period 2017 - 2031. The Newport Neighbourhood Development Plan sets out a number of key objectives and planning policies to be used to help determine planning applications in the Newport area.

The Newport Neighbourhood Development Plan now forms part of the statutory Development Plan for Telford & Wrekin and will be used by the Council to help it decide planning applications in the area of the Town of Newport.
