Dawley Road, Arleston (Service Road)	For the entire length of the service road
Kingsland, Arleston	For its entire length
Kingsway Crescent, Arleston	For its entire length
Manor Road, Arleston	For its entire length
Princess Avenue, Arleston	For its entire length
Stone Crescent, Arleston	For its entire length
Toll Road, Arleston	For its entire length
Woollam Road, Arleston	For its entire length
