

Telford & Wrekin Council Off Street Parking Places Order 2018 – Hall Court Car Park

NOTICE is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin known as Telford & Wrekin Council, in exercise of its enabling powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, intends to make the Telford & Wrekin Council Off Street Parking Places Order 2018 – Hall Court Car Park.

The Order provides a parking place at Hall Court Car Park, Telford Town Centre (“the Parking Place”).

Motor vehicles with a weight greater than 3 tonnes unladen and with a height exceeding 2.5 metres, except for a Public Service Vehicle and Emergency Vehicles, will be restricted from entering and using the Parking Place.

The order shall introduce arrangements for use of the Parking Place, introduce parking charges for use of the Parking Place, introduce parking Permits for use of designated bays within the Parking Place and introduce excess charges for contravention of this Order.

The parking charges for the use of the Parking Place will apply 24 hours a day on every day of the year and will be as set out in the table below:
