### **Improvements in Your Area: The Nedge Ward**

**We will shortly be working in your area as part of our 'Pride in Our Community' investment programme. Between 2017 and 2019 an additional £45 million is being invested in improving the Borough's roads, pavements, street lights and structures. This includes the installation of energy efficient street lights and road signs and a programme of road lining improvements. A list of all highway and transport schemes to be delivered in your area over the next 12 months can be found at the end of this letter.**

As part of the ongoing bridge asset management programme the above structure and adjacent cuttings will be infilled to tie in with existing ground and road levels. The footpaths will be realigned and existing safety barriers removed.

The structure is located on Randlay Avenue within close proximity of Arundel Avenue. These works are currently programmed to start on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2019, and it is anticipated that they will continue for a period of eight weeks. Traffic lights will be used to manage vehicular traffic and diversions will be installed for pedestrians and cyclists.

The contractor carrying out the proposed works will be Fitzgerald Contractors Ltd.

If you have any special access requirements while the works are in progress make them known to the site operatives. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and would appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
