Notice of The Confirmation of an Extinguishment Order

Path under Brookside Avenue Leading from Bournside Drive Parish of Stirchley & Brookside

Footpath Extinguishment Order 2017

On the 08 September 2017 the Authority confirmed the above Order made on 04 July 2017 under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the public footpath which runs from the junction with a slope leading from Bournside Drive and being an entrance to a subway the route which begins at a point before a subway under Brookside Avenue having a width of 4.3 metres and continues east for a distance of 11.2 metres to the junction with the slope being an entrance to the subway and leading to Burnside.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge and copies purchased at Addenbrooke House, Ironmasters Way, Telford on Mondays to Fridays between 9.30 am and 4.00 pm.

The Order comes into force on the date on which the Order is confirmed by the Authority but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to questions its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground it is not within the powers of the above Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published make an application to the High Court.
