ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Telford & Wrekin Council Shop Fronts and Signage Design Guidance in Conservation Areas Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by the Council on Thursday, 26th April, 2012.

The SPD is a design guide to provide guidance property owners and developers regarding shopfronts and signage on period buildings in conservation areas.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
