

TELFORD & WREKIN COUNCIL (NAIRD LANE, TELFORD) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough of Telford & Wrekin (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) proposed to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a prohibition of driving of motor vehicles the following lengths of roads described in the Schedule to this order.

Schedule

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

Column 1	Column 2
Item No.	Length of Road
1) NAIRD LANE	From the administrative boundary in a north-easterly direction to the junction with the Nedge Hill car park.
2) NAIRD LANE TO SHROPSHIRE BOUNDARY	From a point 33 metres east of its junction with Eliot Close in an easterly direction to the administrative boundary.
