## Carriageway improvements in your area

## Resurfacing to improve the condition of your road

Dear Resident.

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads and footpaths, we will shortly be carrying out resurfacing work to improve the condition of the highway on Charlton Street & Vicar Street.

## When are we planning to deliver this work?

00/00/24 42/00/24

The work is due to take place on 9<sup>th</sup> August and be completed by 27<sup>th</sup> August, weather permitting. The works will be carried out under Give & Take traffic management for the civils works then daily Road Closures for the surfacing works, which will be in place on weekdays only. We will be working between 07:30-17:00 on weekdays.

We will be completing the works as detailed below:

09/08/21 - 13/08/21	Civils works (Minor traffic management)
16/08/21 – 18/08/21	Planing Out & Binder Surfacing (Phased ROAD CLOSURES)
18/08/21 – 25/08/21	Civils Works (Phased ROAD CLOSURES)
25/08/21 - 27/08/21	Surfacing Works (Phased ROAD CLOSURES)

Civila Works (Minor troffic management)

We will have our dedicated teams on site to assist you during this time to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do. Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption, we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.

## Information about access to your property

During the civils works access will be maintained when possible for residents and for emergency vehicles although when the surfacing works commence on 16<sup>th</sup> August there will

be times when there will be NO ACCESS for the majority of the day while the new surfacing is being laid. At that time we will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded to allow the surfacing material to be laid and harden. We suggest that all vehicles that you need to use are moved from properties by 9am then can return by 5pm when works are commencing on your street.

We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your cooperation whilst we are undertaking the works.
