FOOTPATH 26 (HILLWICKET) UPGRADE TO BRIDLEWAY
(PARISH OF CHETWYND)
MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

The above Order, made on 4 April 2024 under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by upgrading Footpath 26 to Bridleway Status from the junction with Bridleway 26A on the corner of the garden of Hillwicket House at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SJ 68550 24732, the route continues on a track with an earth surface with a width of approximately 2.5 metres running in a general North-East by North direction for approximately 406 metres where the route adjoins with restricted byway 42 at (OSGR) SJ 68759 25069.
