Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford and Wrekin in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby has made the following Order: Telford & Wrekin Council (Various Roads, Hadley, Hortonwood, Apley & Lilleshall, Telford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2019

This order will come into effect on the 5th November 2019

- When this Order comes into effect, subject to certain exceptions set out in the Order;
 - Waiting will be prohibited at all times on the sides of the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Schedule (No waiting at any time)

- 1. Crescent Road, Hadley (the north side) from a point 22m west of the Centreline of Crescent Road cul-de-sac for a distance of 43m in an easterly direction.
 - 2. Crescent Road, Hadley (the north side) from a point 15m south-west of its junction with Gladstone Street for a distance of 30m in a northeasterly direction.
 - 3. Crescent Road, Hadley (the south side) from a point 20m north-east of the centreline of Gladstone Street for a distance of 145m in a westerly direction.
 - 4. Crescent Road, Hadley (the south side) from a point 48m east of the centreline of Manse Road in a westerly direction to a point opposite the westerly building line of property No.54.
 - 5. Crescent Road Cul-de-sac, Hadley (both sides) from its junction with Crescent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 10m.
 - 6. Gladstone Street, Hadley (both sides) from its junction with Crescent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 10m.
 - 7. High Street, Hadley (the south side) from its junction with Britannia Way in an westerly direction to a point 33m west of its junction with Britannia Way.
 - 8. Hortonwood 50, Hortonwood (the east side) from a point 16m north of its junction with Hortonwood 60 in a southerly direction for a distance of 149m.
 - 9. Hortonwood 60, Hortonwood (both sides) from a point 33m east of its junction with Hortonwood 65 in an easterly direction for a distance of 98m.
 - 10. Hortonwood 60, Hortonwood (both sides) from its junction with Hortonwood 50 in a westerly direction for a distance of 44m.
 - 11. Kingfisher Way, Apley (both sides) from its junction with Grainger Drive in a southerly direction to a point 15m south of its junction with Stonechat Close.
 - 12. Kingfisher Way, Apley (the east side) from a point 27m south of its junction with Grainger Drive for a distance of 38m in a southern direction
 - 13. Kingfisher Way, Apley (the west side) from its junction with Stonechat Close to a point 10m south of its junction with Stonechat Close
 - 14. Manse Road, Hadley (both sides) from its junction with Crescent Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 10m
 - Marlborough Road, Hadley (the south-east side) from its junction with Sommerfeld Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 13m
 Old Farm Lane, Lilleshall (both sides) from its junction with Church Road for a distance of 53m in an easterly direction.
 - Sommerfeld Road, Hadley (the south-west side) from its junction with Marlborough Road for a distance of 33m in a north-westerly direction.
 - Stonechat Close, Apley from its junction with Kingfisher Way in a south-westerly direction for its entire length including the turning head

Any persons wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act have not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court
