

Telford & Wrekin Integrated Place Partnership (TWIPP) Prevention Priority Funding Process and Template Spring 2025

Following recent discussions at TWIPP about the importance of prevention at a place and neighbourhood level, and the national policy drive for a shift from treatment to prevention, the ICB has identified £333,000 non-recurrent funding that we have jointly agreed can be ringfenced for TWIPP prevention priorities.

The funding will:

- Be aligned with the current TWIPP priorities and Health & Wellbeing Strategy
- Be aligned with the STW Integrated Care Strategy and prevention priorities
- Benefit all ages (or ensure a spread of projects across all ages)
- Have measurable impact / outcomes
- Not duplicate services already commissioned, or which should be provided/commissioned by other organisations
- Support neighbourhood working.

To ensure all members of TWIPP are able to influence how this money is allocated the following process will be applied:

- 1. All TWIPP members will be given the opportunity to submit a short funding proposal summary (on a specific template, Appendix A) **by Wednesday 7th May 2025**.
- 2. The opportunities submitted will then be reviewed to ensure they meet the above criteria.
- 3. A short list of 3 projects against each priority (therefore 9 in total) will then be presented to TWIPP on **15 May** for members to vote for the ones they feel are the most beneficial to Telford and Wrekin residents. These will be shared in advance with the agenda and papers for the meeting, providing an opportunity for those who are not able to make the meeting to submit their votes ahead of the meeting.
- 4. The outcome of the TWIPP voting will then be shared back with TWIPP members along with confirmation of next steps.
