Lincoln Road, Telford And Wrekin (the south-east side)	From its junction with New Road in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
2. Lincoln Road, Telford And Wrekin (the south-west side)	From its junction with New Road in a south-westerly direction following the kerb alignment for a distance of 16 metres.
3. New Road, Telford And Wrekin (the north-west side)	From the intersection of the prolongations of the southwestern building line of No.43 New Road in a northeasterly direction for a distance of 75 metres.
4. New Road, Telford And Wrekin (the south-east side)	From the intersection of the prolongations of the north- eastern building line of No.102 New Road in a north- easterly direction for a distance of 80 metres.
