

# Walk & Cycle the Gorge



Why not park your car and explore the Ironbridge Gorge World Heritage Site by foot or bicycle?

This leaflet describes a variety of walks and cycle rides from each of the main car parks in the Gorge.

There are of course

many other footpaths, bridleways and roads in the area. Look out particularly for the marked routes, such as the South Telford Way, which will allow you to search out both the industrial heritage of the area and the modern countryside areas.

Why not hop on the **Gorge Connect bus!** Operating every weekend and Bank Holiday Monday from the beginning of April to the end of October, the bus serves the Ironbridge Gorge area as well as Telford town centre and Telford Central Railway Station.

Bus timetables and further tourist information can be obtained from the Tourist Information Centre in the **Tollhouse** at the southern end of the Iron Bridge.




