

Borough of Telford & Wrekin (Bridge Road and Ladywood, Ironbridge) (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin are proposing to make the above named Order under Sections 82, 83 and 84 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 30mph speed limit along the following length(s) of road(s) as shown below:

1	LADYWOOD From its junction with Ironbridge Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 420 metres.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 30mph speed limit by replacing the De-restricted section of Ladywood that links into the Restricted Road (30mph) which is a road that has a system of street lighting. This is located further down of Ladywood near the Ironbridge car park. The purpose of the Order is to reduce the speed limits along this single carriageway that would help towards road safety for cyclists and pedestrians.
