TWC/2021/1172 – The Priory, Newport Road, Edgmond – Restoration works to main dwellings & outbuildings consisting of repairs to existing sash windows, patch repairs & painting of existing render, full replacement of 4no. windows & 1no. door in south elevation, formation of internal loft access hatch in existing en-suite, repair & strengthening to internal landing staircase, installation of air bricks to west & south gables, restoration & repair of existing chimney stacks, replacement of damaged roof tiles, replacement of existing flat roof on south elevation with grey membrane, installation of 2no. 3m high electric gates, restoration to perimeter wall & pillars, installation of glazed roof to attached greenhouse & installation of 1no. satellite dish (Listed Building Application)

TWC/2021/1173 – The Priory, Newport Road, Edgmond – Installation of 2no. electric 3 metre gates to access points 'A' and 'B', restoration to perimeter wall & pillars, installation of glazed roof to attached greenhouse & placing of 1no. satellite dish (Full Planning Application)

TWC/2021/1174 – Site of Stairplan, Hortonwood 1, Hortonwood – Erection of one industrial unit (Use Class B2/B8)

TWC/2021/1179 – Land at Hadley Quarry, Hadley Road, Hadley – Erection of 188no. dwellings together with formation of new vehicular accesses, landscaping, attenuation pond & associated infrastructure

TWC/2021/1180 & TWC/2021/1181 – The Gate Lodge, Pave Lane, Chetwynd Aston – Replacement of existing panel fence with new post & rail fence 1.4 metres high & installation of new vehicular gates & gate posts 1.4 metres high (Full Planning & Listed Building Applications)

TWC/2021/1182 – 5 Market Square, Wellington – Installation of new replacement shop frontage (Part-Retrospective)
