



Arts Award Discover


Creating a universal entitlement to arts and culture for all children and young people linked to a Virtual School in the West Midlands

We are pleased to announce that 6 of our young people in Telford & Wrekin have successfully achieved their Discover Arts Award. This was undertaken over a 1 day Creating Art Through Nature event during the April 2022 half term. This was delivered by the Student Engagement Programme Team.

The one day Creating Art Through Nature event consisted of finding out about artists inspired by nature and recreate their art. The artist that the young person researched was Andrew Goldsworthy. Discover nature art and created their own nature mandala. The children used different materials and items such as pastels, paint, felt pens to recreate Andrew Goldsworthy pictures and then created similar art using items from nature. The children then shared their art with others.
