Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford & Wrekin proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 82 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a speed limit of 30mph & 40mph along the following lengths of roads described in the Schedule One and Schedule Two to this order.

Schedule One (30mph speed limit)	
1.	Forest Glen to Spout Lane junction – from its junction with Forest Glen to M54 junction, in a Easterly direction for a distance of 280m
2.	Forest Glen to M54 junction - from its junction with Ercall Lane, in a north westerly direction for a distance of 325m
3.	Ercall Lane – from its junction with Forest Glen to M54 junction, in a northerly direction for a distance of 1455m
4.	Wrekin Coarse – from its junction with Forest Glen to M54 junction, in a westerly direction for a distance of 10m

Schedule Two (40mph speed limit)	
1.	Forest Glen to Spout Lane junction – from a point 280m East of its junction with Forest Glen to
	M54, in a southerly direction for a distance of 675m
2.	Forest Glen to M54 junction – from a point 325m north west of its junction with Ercall Lane, in a

northerly direction for a distance of 360m
