

TELFORD AND WREKIN COUNCIL (LEONARD CLOSE AREA, DONNINGTON) (PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that Borough of Telford and Wrekin in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2) and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the Act hereby propose to make the following Order: Telford and Wrekin Council (Leonard Close Area, Donnington) (Prohibitions and Restrictions of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2021

1. When this Order comes into effect;
 - Waiting will be prohibited at all times on the length of roads specified in Schedule One to this Order to the extent specified.
 - Waiting will be restricted from 2.30pm to 3.30pm Monday to Friday inclusive on the lengths or roads specified in Schedule Two to this Order to the extent specified.

Schedule One (No waiting at any time)	
1. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the north-east side)	From its junction with Winifred's Drive in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres. From its junction with the north-eastern cul-de-sac of Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
2. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the north-west side)	(North-eastern cul-de-sac) from its junction with Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres. (South-western cul-de-sac) from its junction with Leonard Close in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
3. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the south-east side)	(North-eastern cul-de-sac) from its junction with Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres. (South-western cul-de-sac) from its junction with Leonard Close in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
4. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the south-west side)	From its junction with Winifred's Drive in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres. From its junction with the south-western cul-de-sac of Leonard Close in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 19 metres.
5. Winifreds Drive, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the north-west side)	From a point 12.5 metres south-west of the prolongation of the south-western kerb of Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 44 metres.
6. Winifreds Drive, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the south-east side)	From its junction with Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres. From its junction with Leonard Close in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

Schedule Two (No Waiting - Part Time - Mon-Fri 2.30pm-3.30pm)	
1. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the north-east side)	from a point 29 metres north-west of its junction with the north-eastern cul-de-sac of Leonard Close in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 16 metres
2. Leonard Close, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the south-west side)	From a point 35 metres north-west of its junction for the south-western cul-de-sac of Leonard Close in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.
3. Winifreds Drive, Donnington, Telford And Wrekin (the south-east side)	From a point 12 metres north-east of its junction with Leonard Close in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
