On 25th September 2019 the Authority confirmed the above order, made on 6th August 2019 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, the effect of this Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by diverting the public footpath commencing from its junction with St Mary's Street Newport on the eastern side of the access (grid ref: SJ 74467 19239) and continuing between buildings in a north-north east direction with a width of 1.2m for a distance of 112 m to its junction with Water Lane (grid ref: SJ 74546 19311) to a route commencing from its junction with St Mary's Street Newport on the western side of the access (grid ref: SJ 74467 19239) and continuing between buildings in a north-north east direction with a width of 1.2m for a distance of 110 m to its junction with Water Lane (grid ref: SJ 74536 19317) as shown on the Order Map, and also provide for the required consequential amendment of the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Shropshire

The Order came into force on 25th September 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Schedule 15 paragraph 12 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice make an application to the High Court.
