Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016. Registration of a T7 exempt waste operation

With reference to the exempt waste operation registration form received by this Council for Besblock Ltd to operate a T7 exempt waste operation.

Besblock Ltd is hereby registered to operate a T7 exempt waste operation as described under Schedule 3, Chapter 3, Section 2 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016.

The Exempt waste operation detailed in Section 1 of this Registration shall be operated in accordance with the Standard Conditions detailed in Section 2 of this Registration.

Section 1 - Exempt Waste Operation

1.1. T7 exempt waste operation entailing:

The treatment of relevant waste by crushing, grinding or reducing it in size but not including any treatment activity covered by paragraph (c) in Part B of Section 3.5 of Part 2 of Schedule 1.

Crushing concrete blocks that have been made on site, that are either damaged or not fit for sale. Using a telehandler mounted jaw crusher, model number MB L200 S2 capable of crushing 22m² per hour. Material will be crushed and stored within an onsite 3-sided aggregate bay.

1.2. The exempt waste operation shall only be carried out at: Besblock Ltd, Site 1 and 2, Halesfield 21, Telford, TF7 4NF 1.3. The Primary point of contact in relation to this registration is: Mark Whistance

1.4. Relevant Waste:

Section 2 – Standard Conditions

- **2.1** The total quantity of waste treated over any period of 1 hour does not exceed 20 tonnes.
- 2.2 The total quantity of waste stored at any one time does not exceed 200 tonnes.
- 2.3 The waste is stored in a secure place prior to treatment.
- **2.4** The treatment is carried on:
 - (i) At the place of production, or
 - (ii) at the place where the treated waste is to be used; and

Section 3 - Registration Further Information

3.1 - Validity if Registration

The registration is valid for three years from 24 August 2022. A record of the registration will be held a Telford and Wrekin Council at the address above for the duration that it remains in force. You may renew the registration at any time in the month prior to the date of expiry of the registration, i.e. during one month prior to 24 August 2025.

3.2 - Changes to the Registration

Telford and Wrekin Council must be notified of any change to the particulars of the registration, such as a change to the exempt waste operation or to the details of the nominated contact. This notification must be provided in writing to the postal address above or by email to: environmentalprotectionteam@telford.gov.uk

3.3 - Failure to Comply with the Registration

It is an offence, under Regulation 38(1), to operate an exempt waste operation above the threshold stated in Schedule 3 of the Environmental Permitting Regulations. The penalty for such an offence is, upon conviction in a magistrate's court, a fine and/or up to 6 months imprisonment or, upon conviction in a crown court, an unlimited fine and/or up to 2 years imprisonment. Please contact the Telford and Wrekin Council immediately if you think your waste operation may be exceeding the threshold for exemption.
