Notice of Confirmation of Public Path Order

Town and Country Planning Act 1990, Section 257 and Paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 Borough of Telford and Wrekin

Footpath 1 Parish of Chetwynd Aston & Woodcote

Diversion Order 2 of 2015

On 28 February 2018 the Secretary of State for Environment Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above Order with modifications. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from a point just to the east of the existing stile and 15 metres north-east of Station Road the route being an unsurfaced path having a width of 1 metre continues north-east for a distance of 80 metres to a point 5 metres west of the existing stile and create an alternative footpath for use as a replacement to a line running from a point just to the east of the existing stile and 15 metres north-east of Station Road the route being a surfaced path having a width of 1.5metres continues in a general northerly direction for a distance of 40 metres to cross the estate road then continues in a general easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres to cross the estate road then continues east for a further 15 metres then continues south for a distance of 20 metres then continues east for a distances of 15 metres to a point 5 metres west of the existing stile.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge and purchased at Addenbrooke House, Ironmasters Way, Telford on Mondays to Fridays between 9.30 am and 4.00 pm.

This Order will come into effect on the date on which Telford and Wrekin Council certify to the Secretary of State for Environment Food and Rural Affairs that there has been created, to the satisfaction of the Telford and Wrekin Council, a public footpath over the land; if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
