# Carriageway Improvements in your area Turreff Avenue, Donnington

Dear Resident

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads and footpaths, we will shortly be carrying out re-surfacing works on Turreff Avenue, Donnington to improve the condition of the carriageway.

## When are we planning to deliver this work?

- Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 2) 0800-1730hrs
- Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 1) 0800-1730hrs
- Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 2) 0800-1730hrs
- Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 1) 0800-1730hrs
- Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October (PHASE 1) 0800-1730hrs
- Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October (PHASE 3) 2000hrs-0600hrs
- Monday 24<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 3) 0800-1730hrs
- Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> October (PHASE 1/2/3 Rolling Closures for Road Markings & Gully Emptying) 0800-1730hrs

The works will be carried out under road closures in phases.

## PHASE 1

Road Closure at Baldwins Gate to the Crescent – Diversion down Wrekin Drive onto Wellington Road onto Turreff Avenue.

## PHASE 2

Road Closure from Wellington Road to The Crescent – Diversion from Wellington Road to Wrekin Drive onto Turreff Avenue.

## PHASE 3

Road Closure from Wrekin Drive onto Turreff Avenue (Outside Home Bargains) – Diversion on Wrekin Drive to Hayward Avenue onto Turreff Avenue.

All dates are provisional on weather.

We will have our dedicated teams on site to assist you during this time to help you get past the working areas safely should you need to do. Whilst we will endeavour to minimise disruption, we ask that you keep vehicle movements to an absolute minimum and not to park on the road. Please also ensure that children are supervised, do not play near the working areas and all pets are kept away from the works.

### Information about access to your property

Access will be maintained during the works for residents and for emergency vehicles although there will be short periods of time when the contractors will require residential and commercial traffic to be excluded during planning of the road surface and to allow the surfacing material to harden. We will try to cause as little inconvenience as possible and really appreciate your co-operation whilst we are undertaking the works.
