Telford and Wrekin Council (Various Roads Hollinswood) (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2018

- 1. This Experimental Order will come into effect on the 13th day of February 2018 for a period not exceeding eighteen months.
- 2. The effect of this Experimental Order is parking will be prohibited at all times along the sides and lengths of road as described in the table below.

Dunsheath, Hollinswood (both sides)	From a point 23m from its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 79m in an easterly direction on the southern side. From its junction with Dunsheath for a distance of 90m in an easterly direction on the northern side.
Downemead, Hollinswood (both side)	From a point 58 metres south of its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 76m, in a southerly direction on the western side. From a point 50 metres south of its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 99m, in a southerly direction on the eastern side.
Dudmaston, Hollinswood (both sides)	From its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 29m in an easterly direction on the northern side. From a point 9m into Dudmaston (side road) for a distance 68m in a southerly direction on the east side From its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 80m in an southerly direction on the western side
Dallamoor, Hollinswood (both sides)	From its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 83m in a westerly direction on the northern side. From its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 84m in a westerly direction on the southern side. From a point 10m from its junction with Dallamoor for a distance of 26m in a north easterly direction then in a northern direction
Darliston, Hollinswood (both sides)	From its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 15m in a southerly direction.
Deepdale, Hollinswood (both sides)	From a point 12m from its junction with Dale Acre Way for a distance of 53m in a northerly direction
Dale Acre Way, Hollinswood (south side)	From a point 14m from its junction with the surgery entrance for a distance of 96m in a westerly direction

Within a period of six months beginning with the day on which the Experimental Order came into force, or if any or all of the Experimental Order provisions are varied or modified by the Council, beginning with the day the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making permanent of the Experimental Order.
