Key Points from discussion on the draft easy read Learning Disability Strategy:

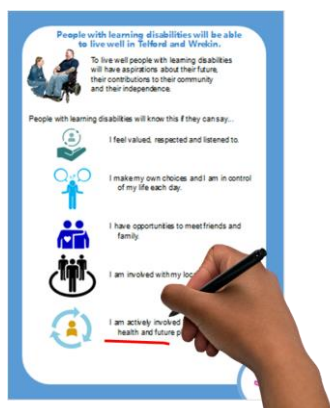


- 'I' statement feedback:

- 'I' have one plan

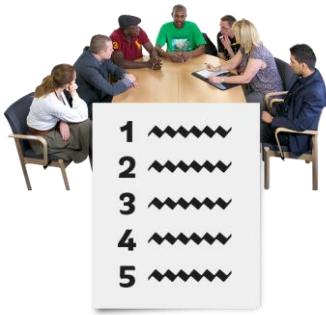


ACTION- Consider the above feedback as part of the consultation responses.
